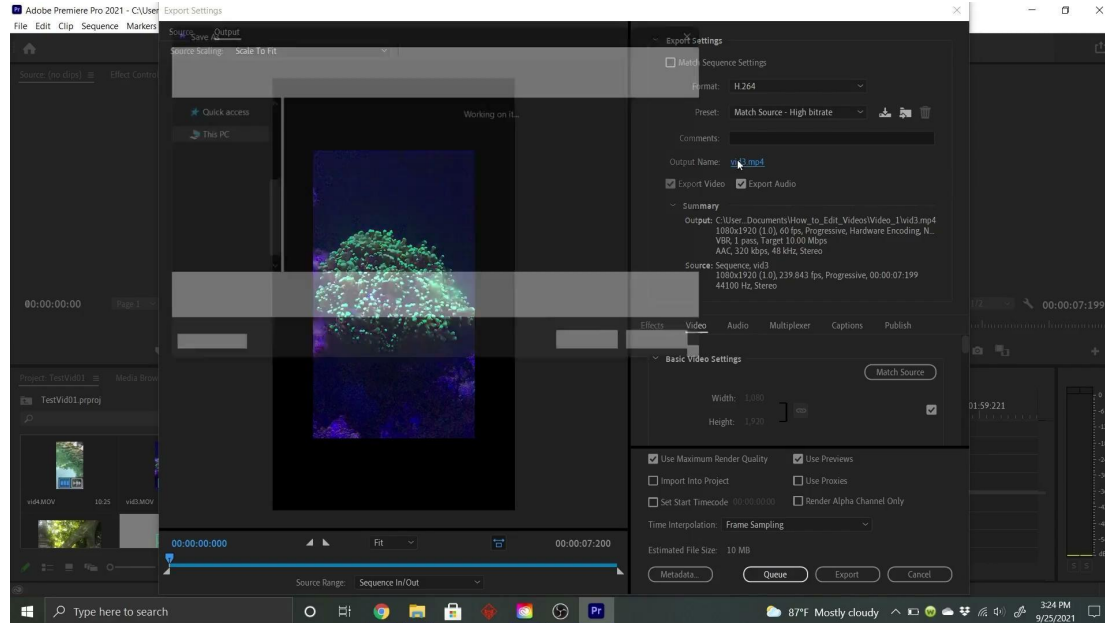

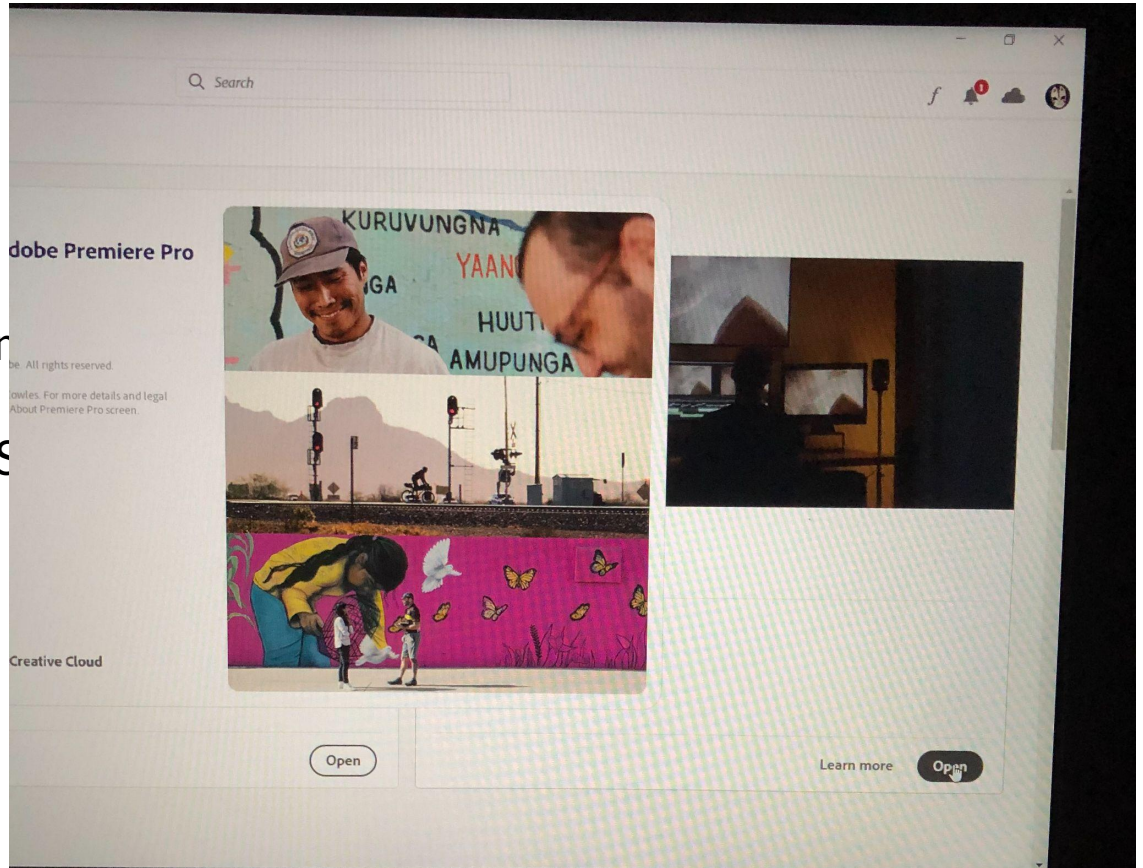

Starting to Edit

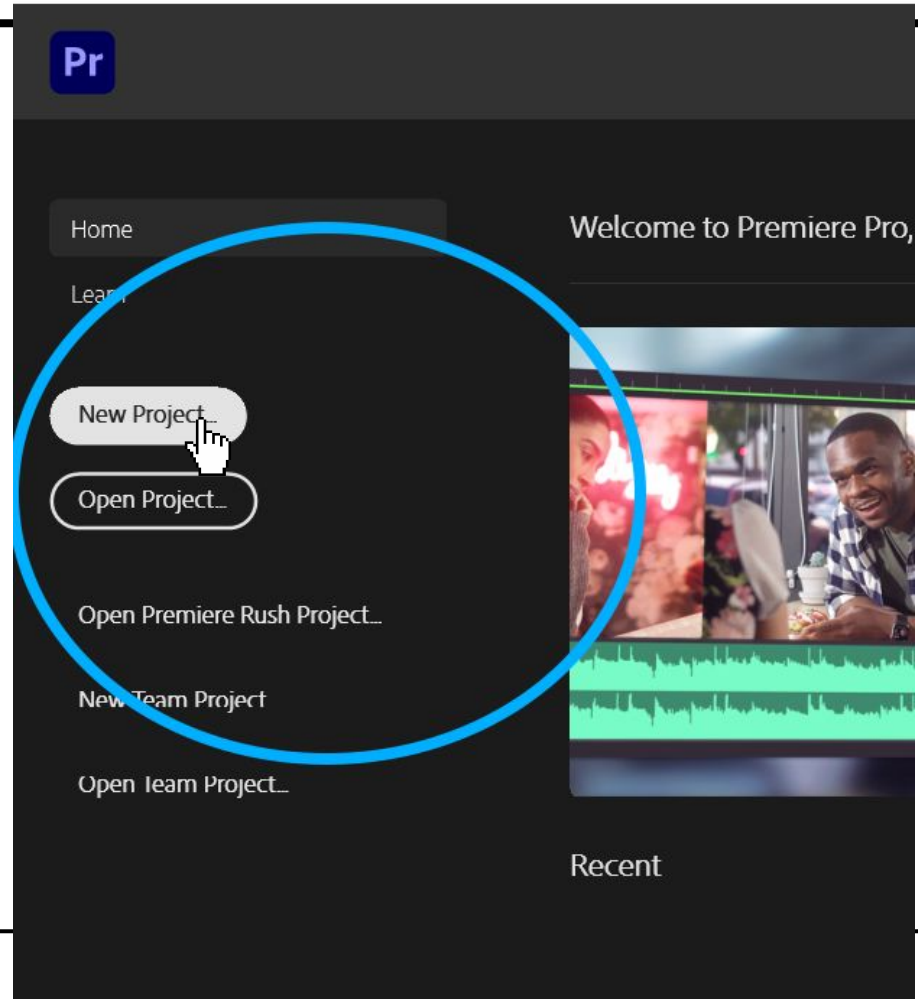
Open software program - Premiere

Pro from the Adobe Creative S

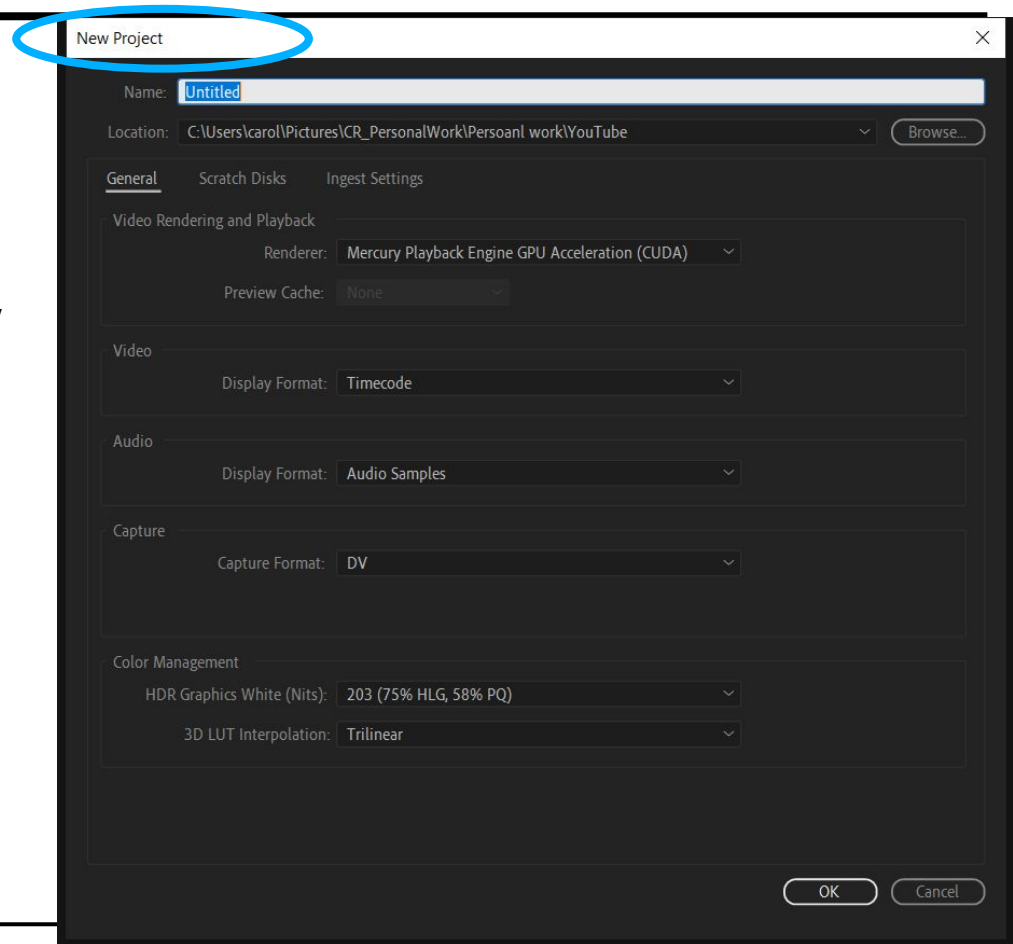


To Begin

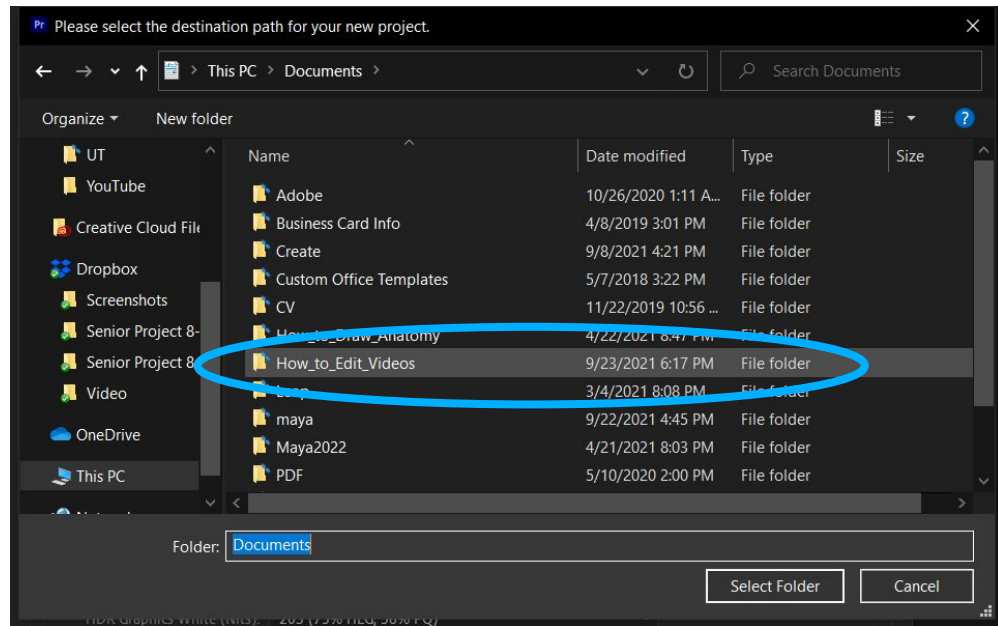
Select on new project



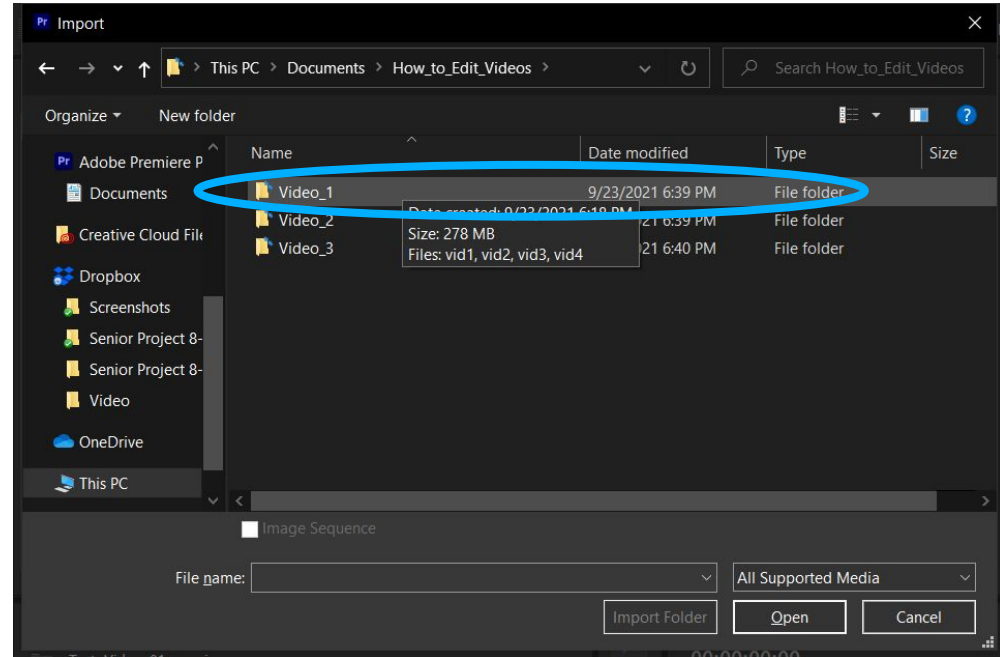
Or it will open automatically to a new project window



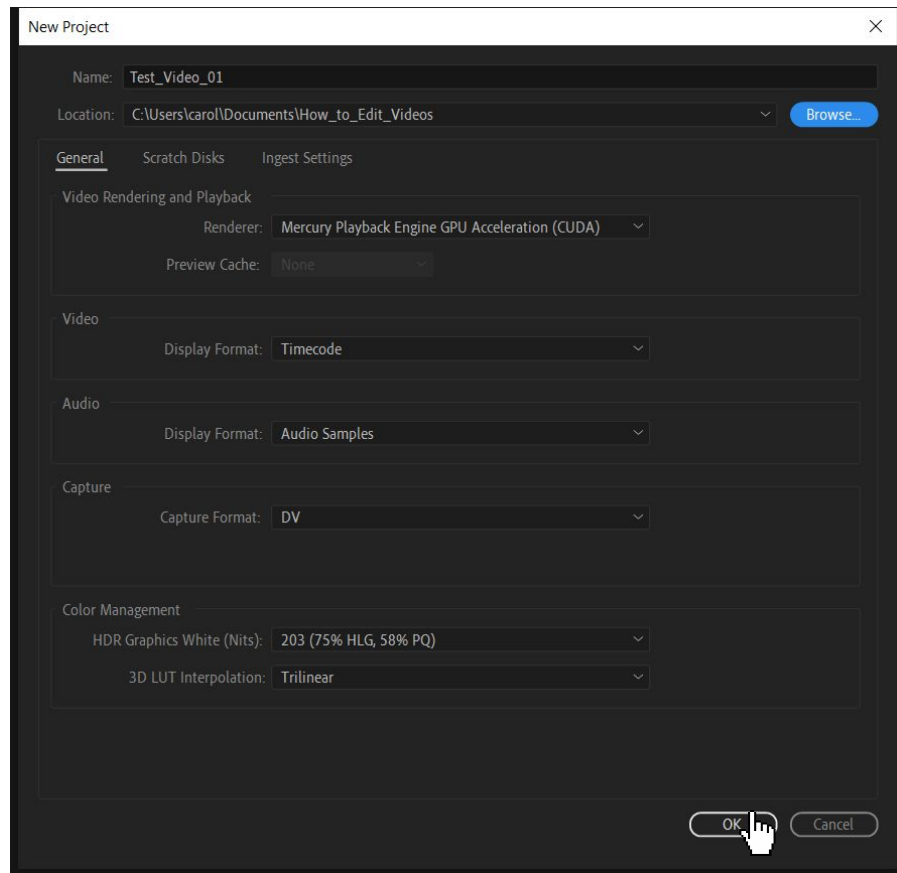
Select the main folder provided to you, named How_to_Edit_Videos that holds video folders 1-3



The folder you will save your first edited video in is Video_1 - these folders with videos and audio will be provided to the learner

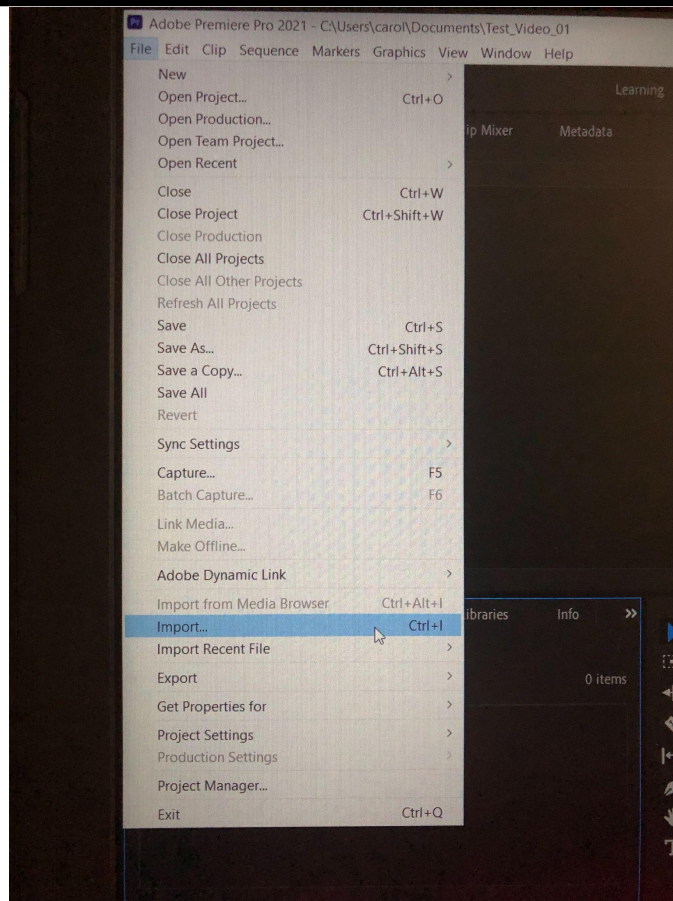


Name the video and where to
save it then press OK



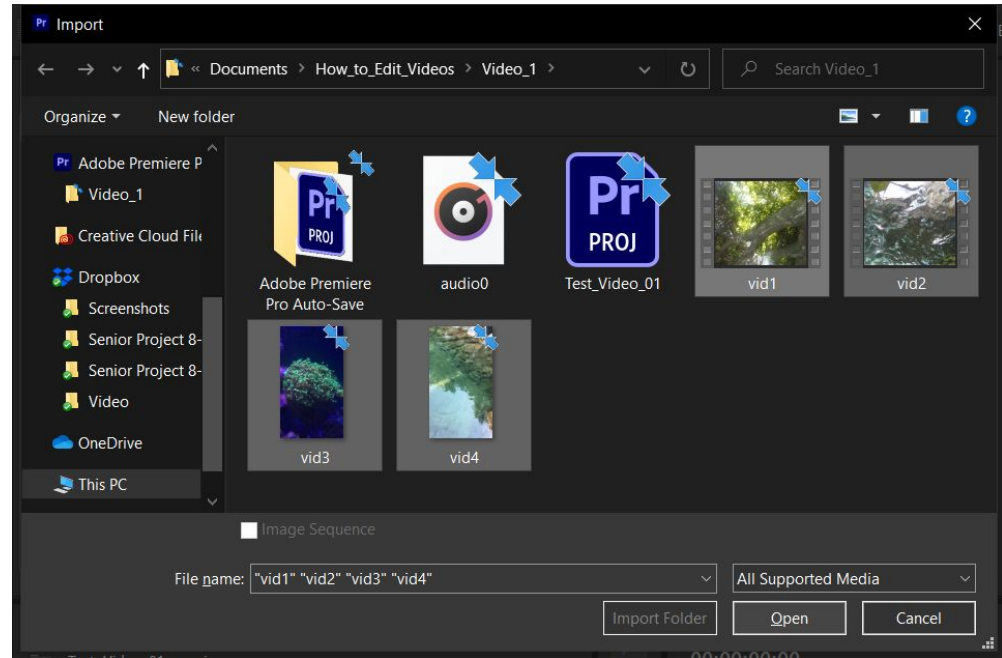
Importing Videos

Go to file (top left corner of screen) > import > select what videos you wish to edit then press open



Select video 1 then hit shift to select up to video 4 and then press okay

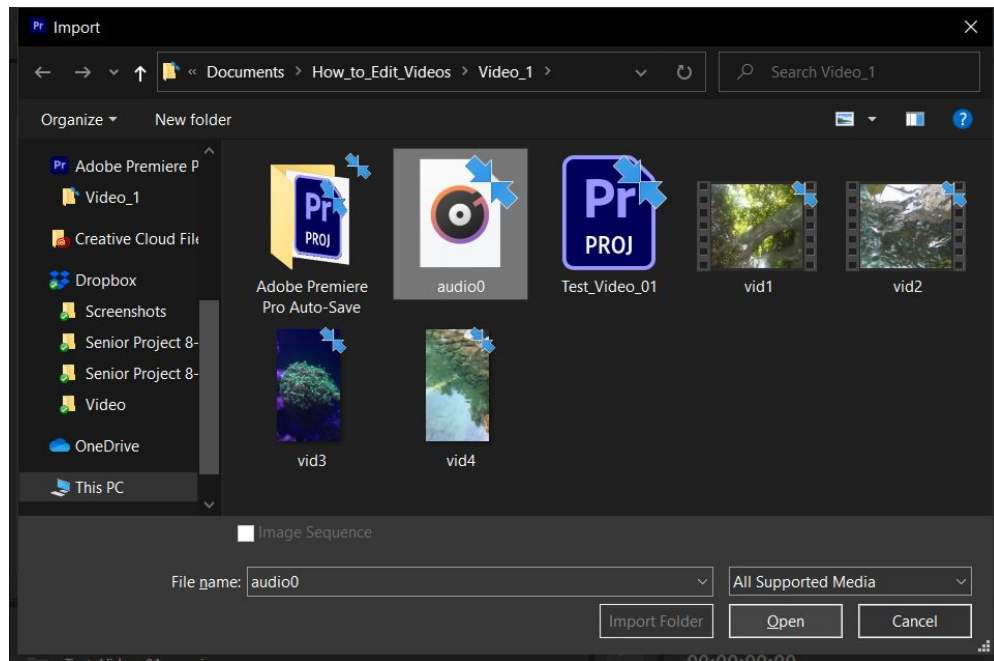
On a tablet it will be selecting all 4 videos individually and pressing okay



Importing Audio

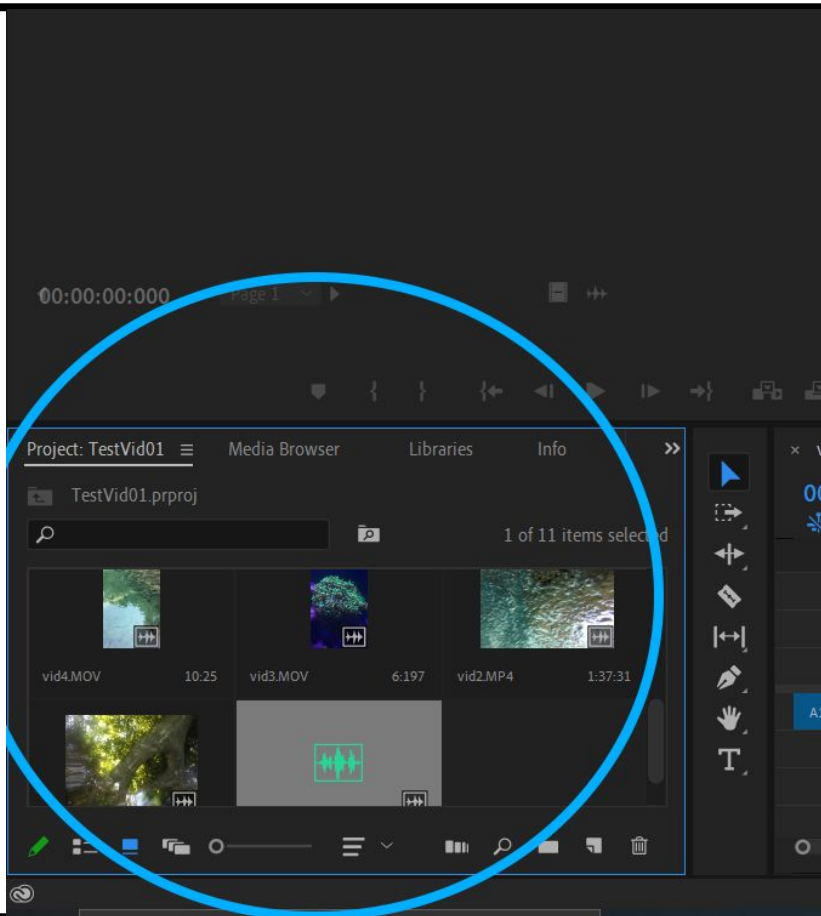
Do the same as you did for the video but select the audio and press okay

On a tablet it will be selecting the audio and press okay



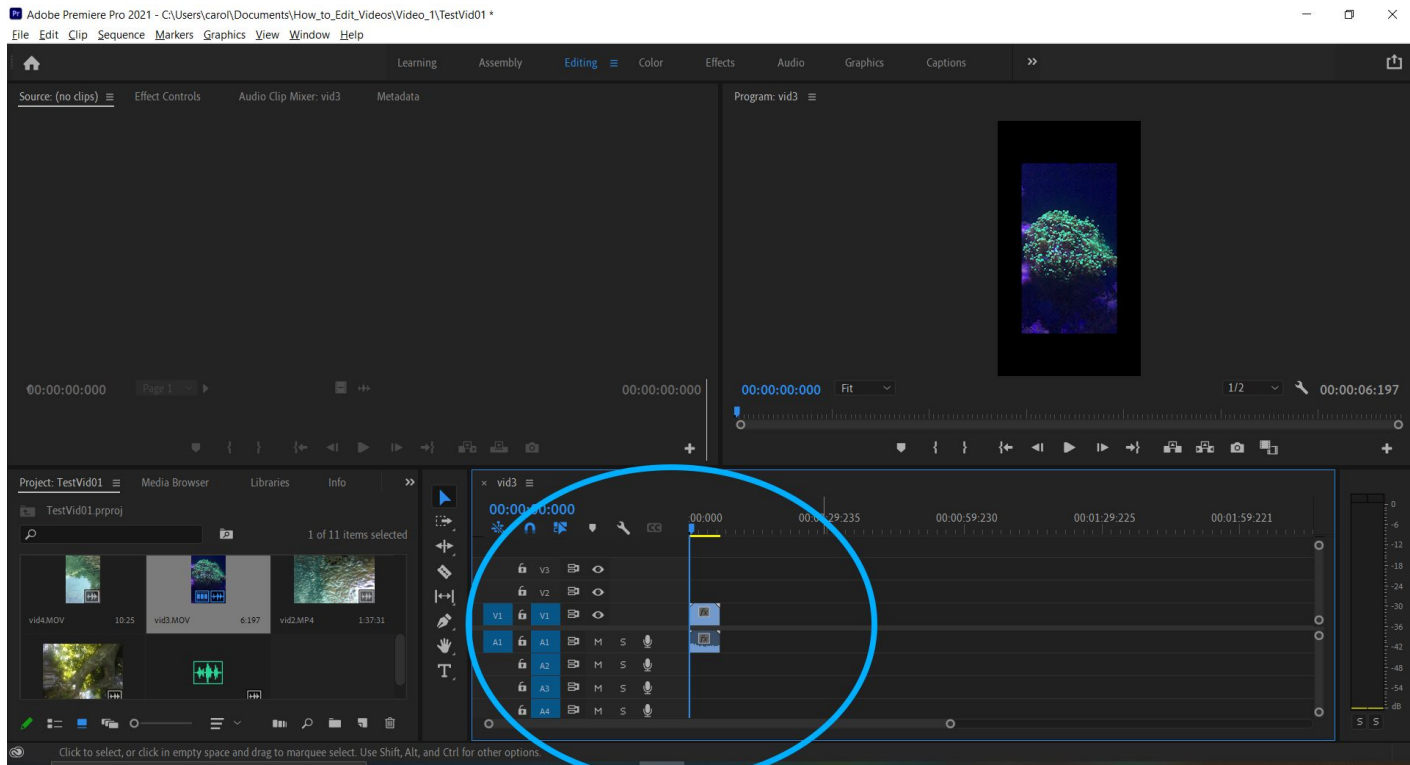
Project Window

Now your videos and audio should be in the project window



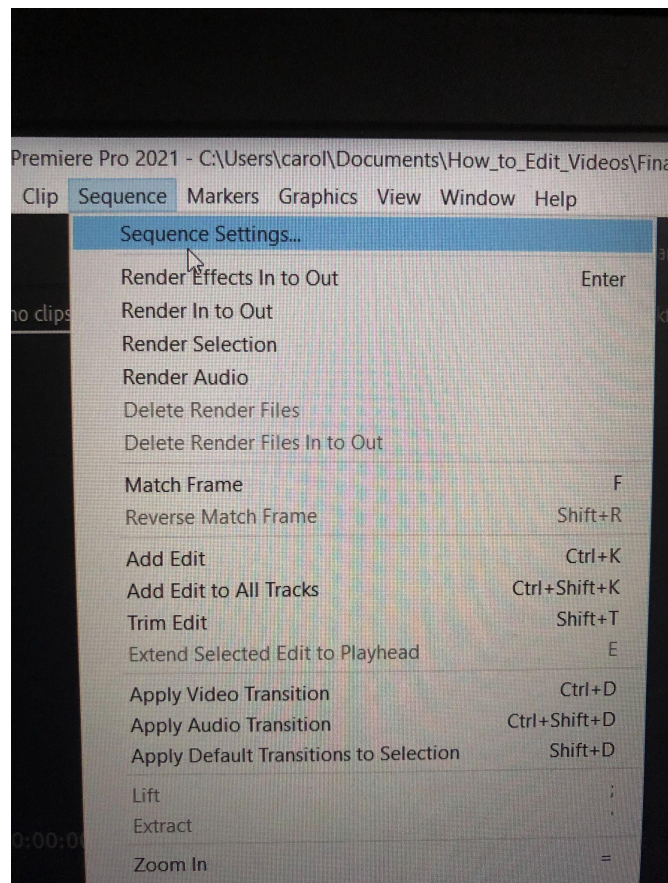
Timeline

Once done importing click on the video(s) and audios just imported and drag them into the timeline



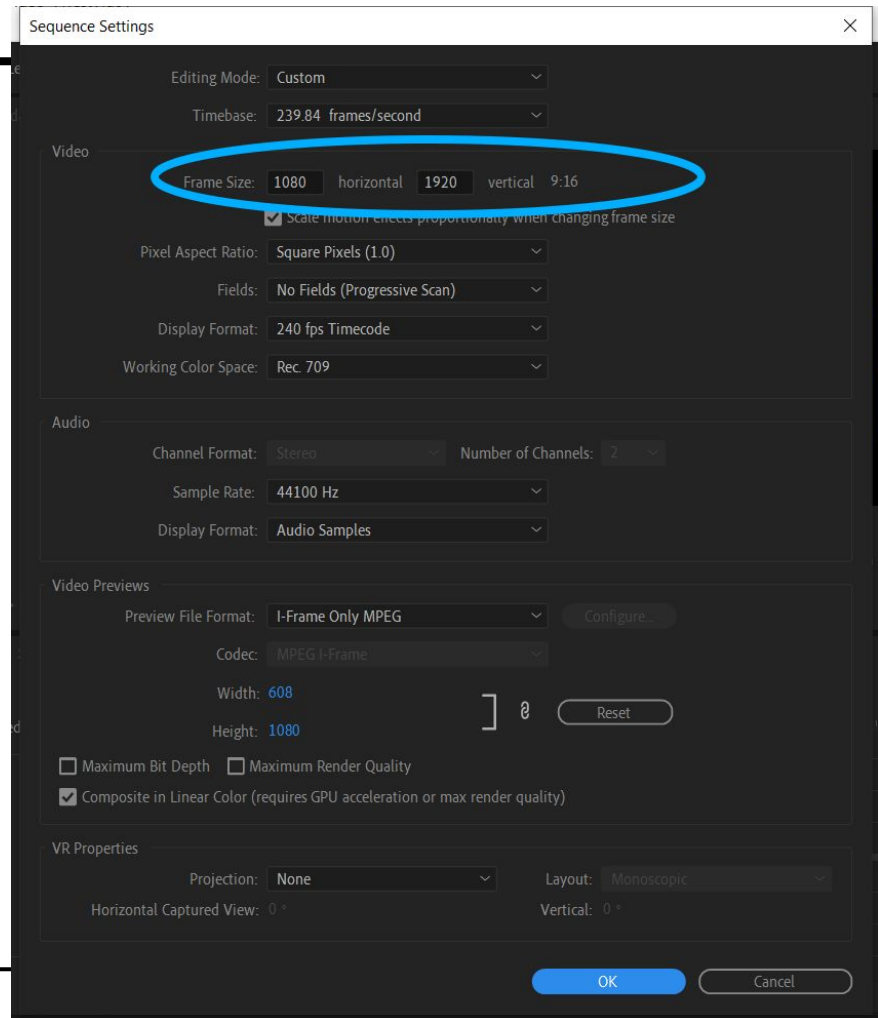
Sequence Settings

Then go to Sequence > select on
Sequence Settings



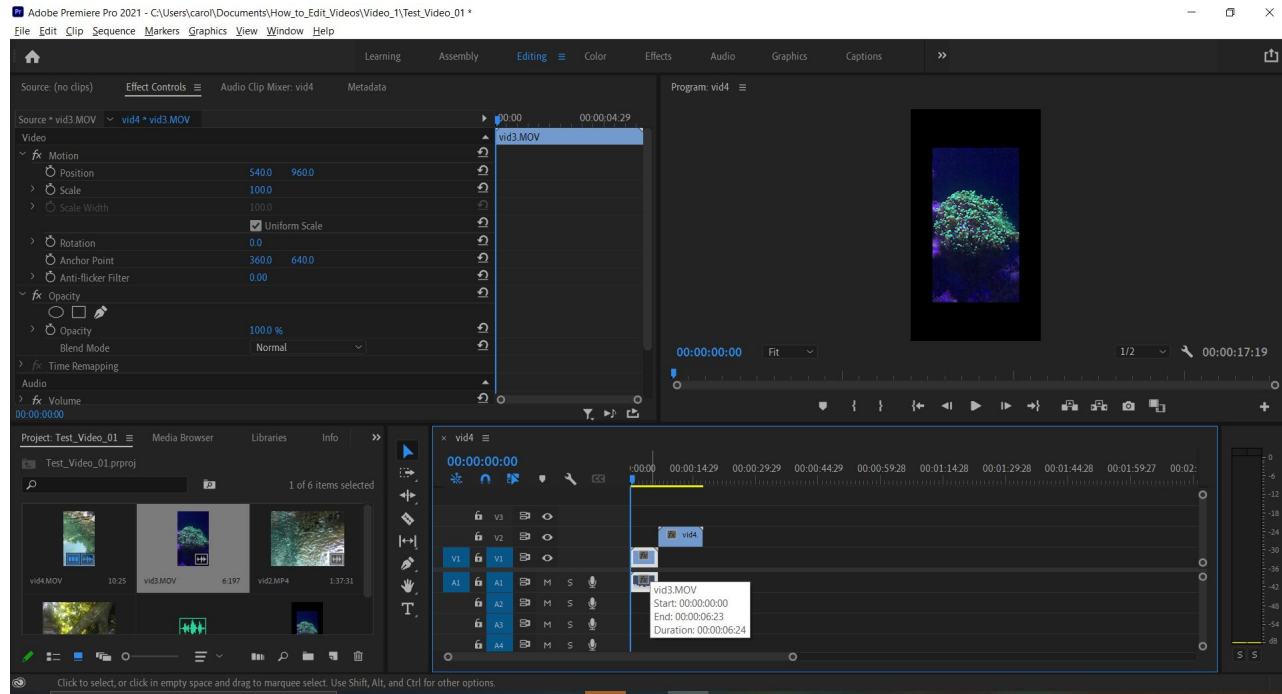
1080 x 1920

Then go under the video heading and make sure the Frame size is 1080 and Horizontal by 1920 vertical (1080 x 1920) or a 9 to 16 ratio (9:16) then select OK



How to Unlink Video and Audio

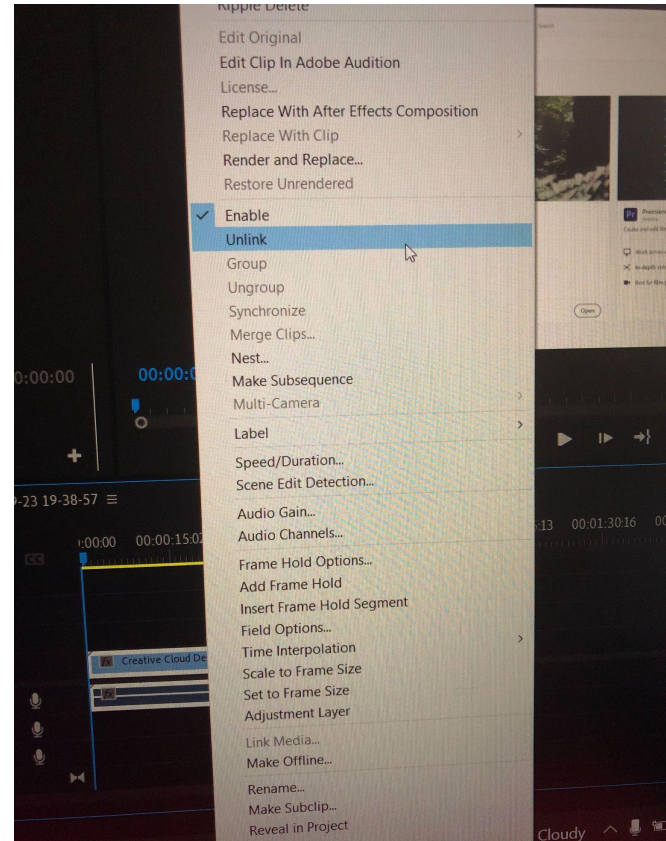
Once video is in the timeline you can start by either keeping the original audio that your video contains or erasing it



Unlinking Video and Audio

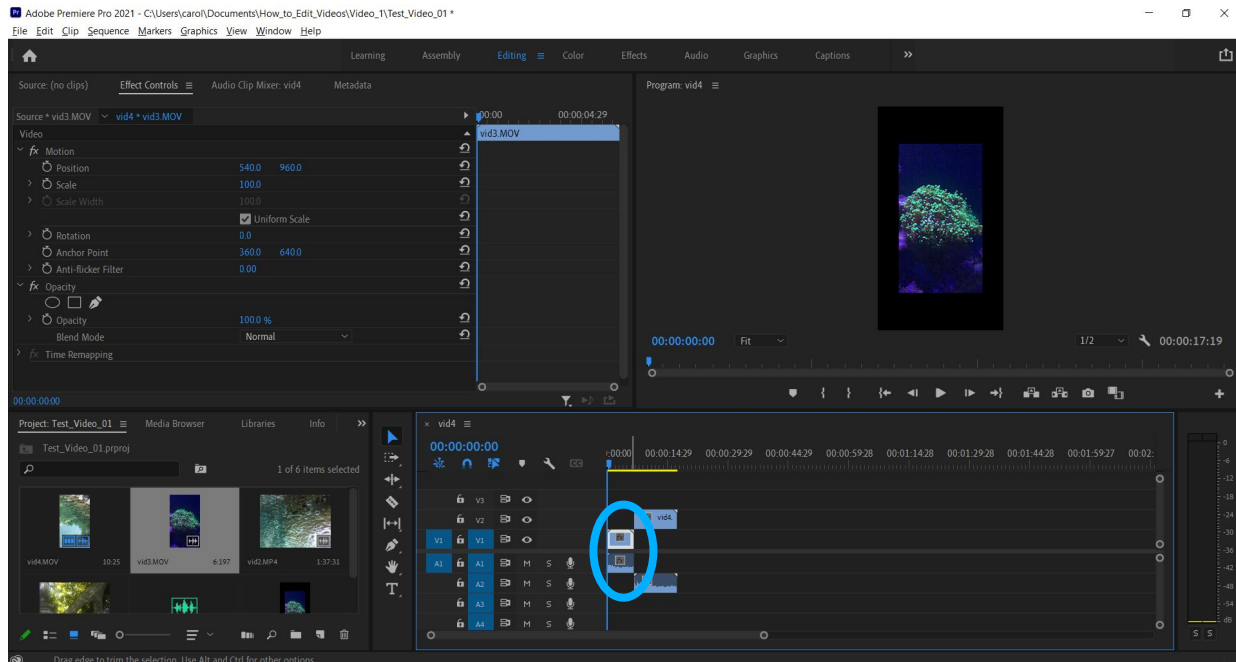
To erase the original audio, right click or select on the film in the timeline that you want delete the audio from and select on unlink and your video and audio are now separated. You can now delete your audio and replace it with new audio.

*Note for computers you can also use the ALT key, and click then press delete to unlink your videos and audio faster.



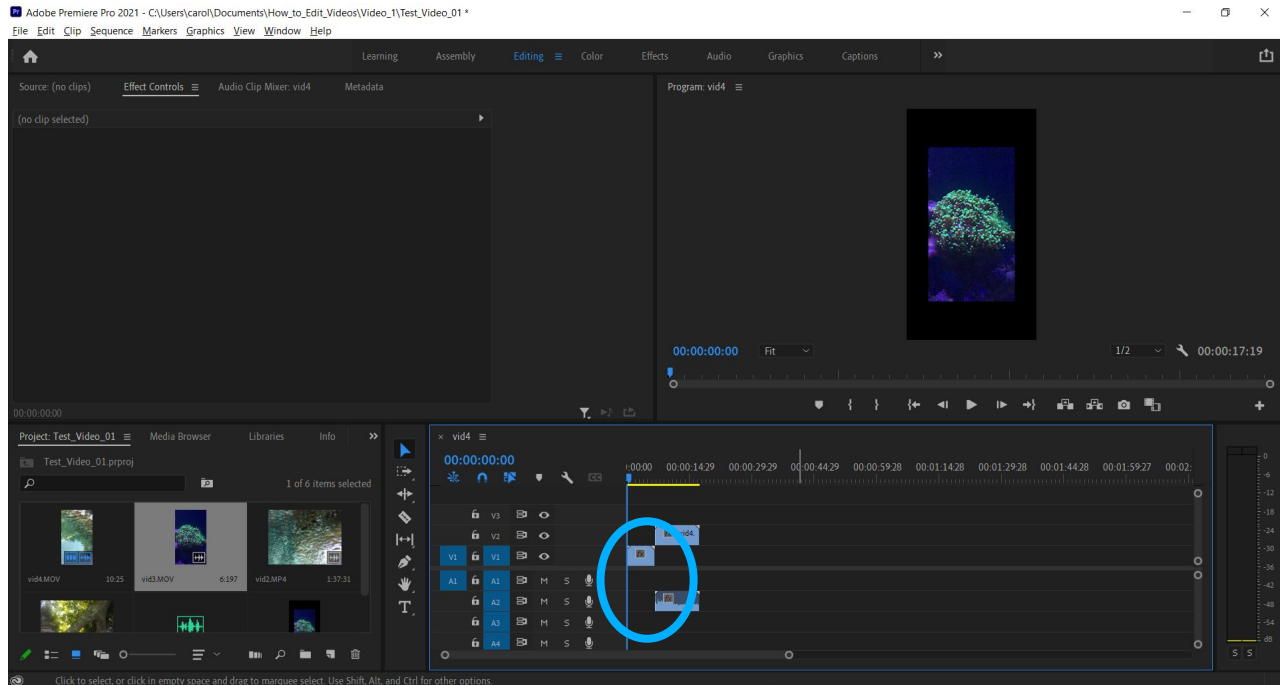
Video and Audio is now Unlinked

Showing video and audio is unlinked

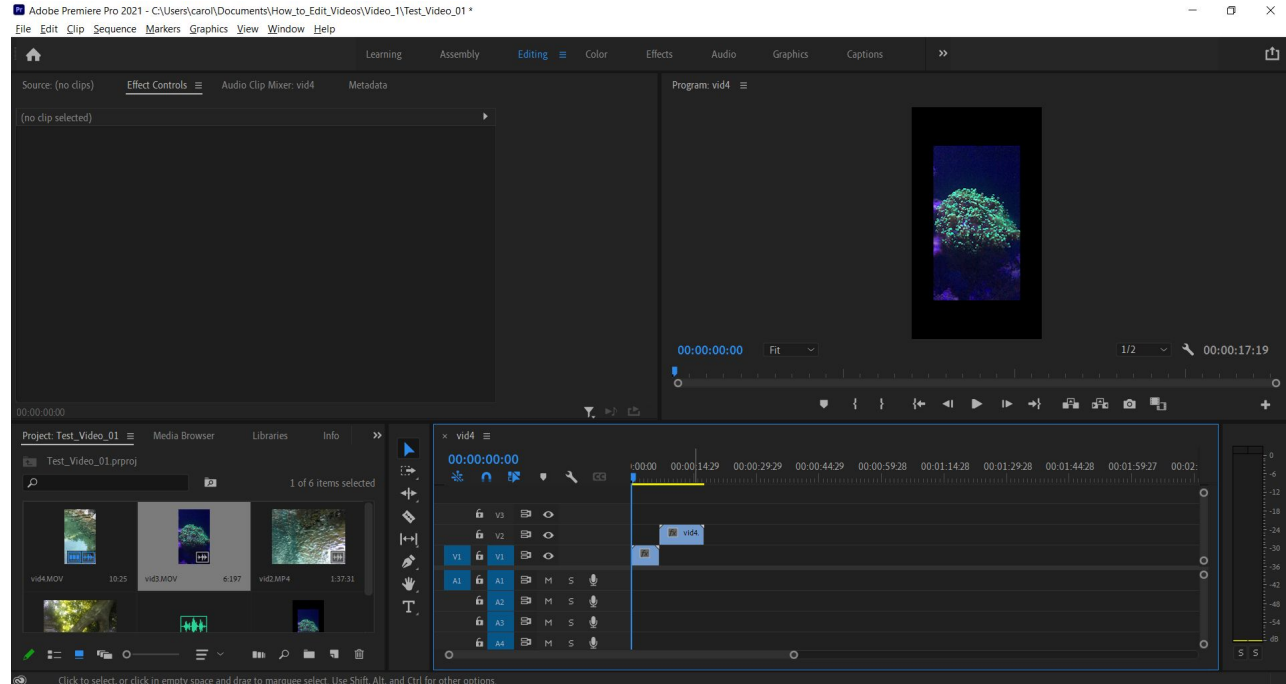


Able to Delete Audio

You can now delete the audio as shown in the picture



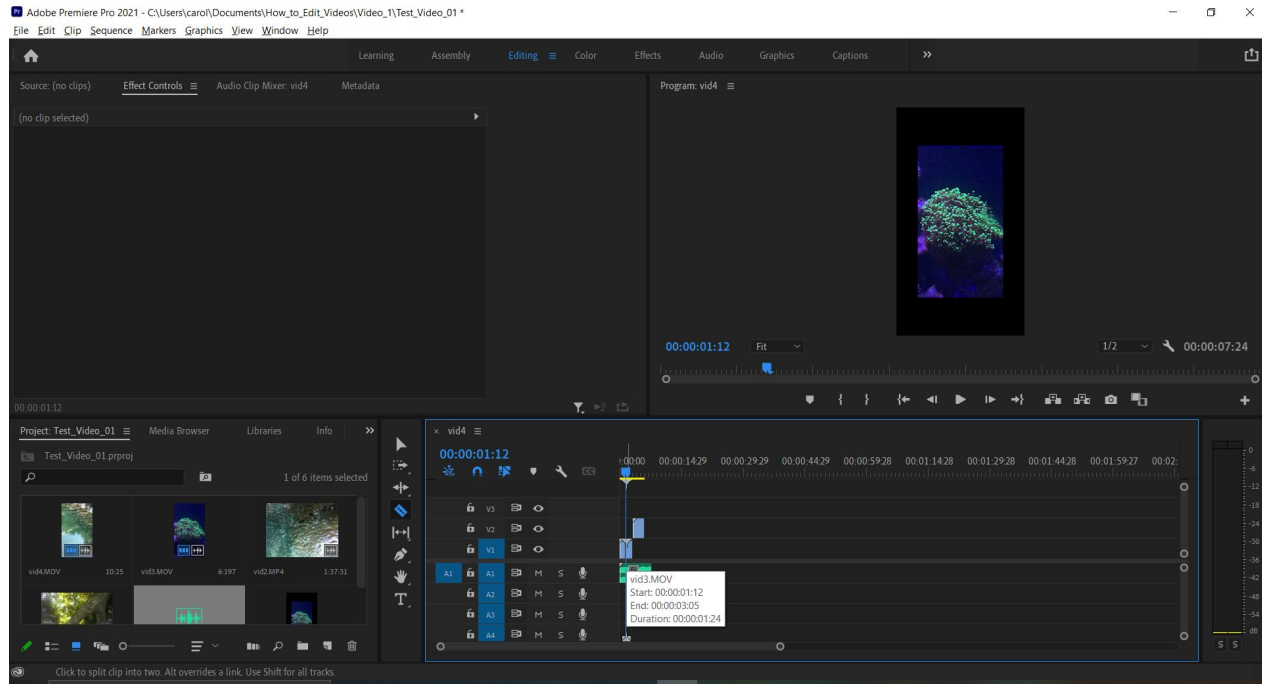
The audio is now
deleted for the videos



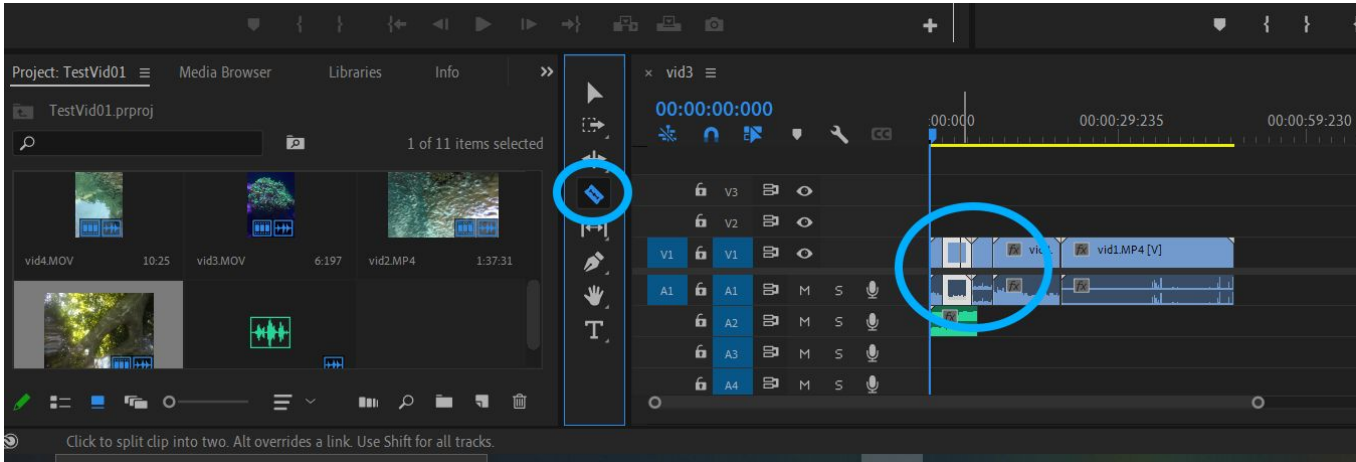
How to Cut Videos

We are then going to cut the videos to match up with the audio.

*Note: You don't have to follow the cuts made in the video or in the pictures. Please take creative liberty or you can follow the video or pictures as you like.

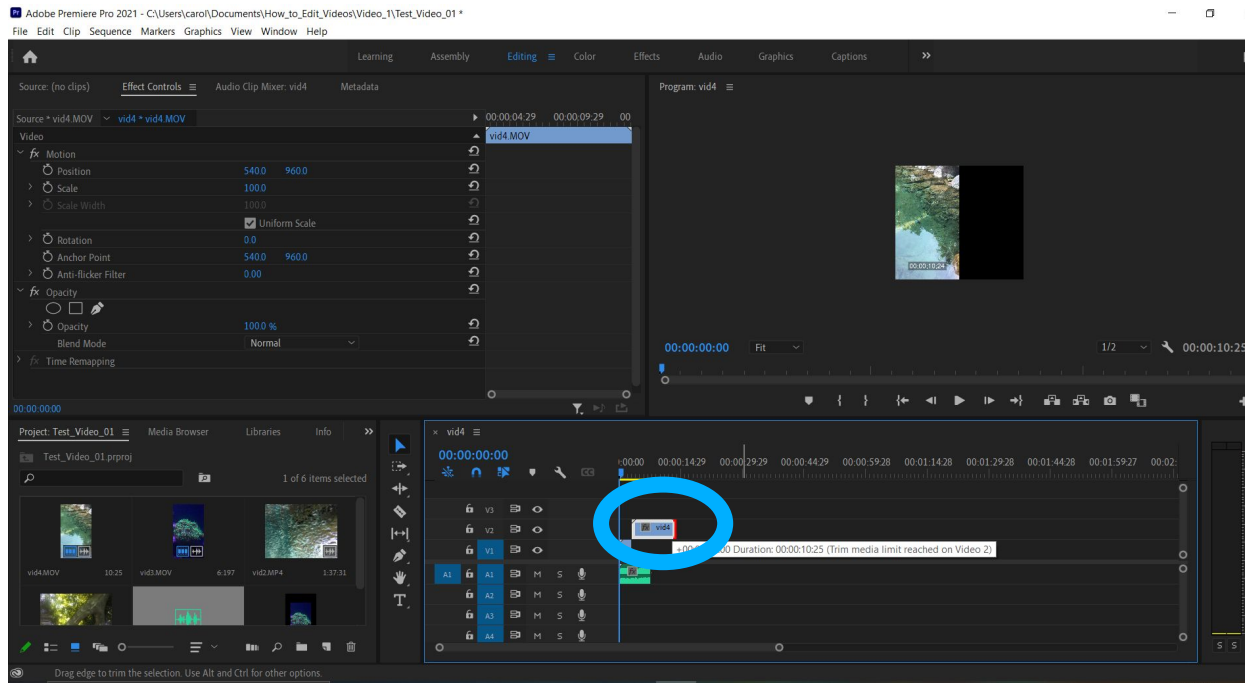


To do this we use the razor tool to cut the videos to match up to the audio, you are allowed creative liberty to cut the videos as you please or follow along with the video.

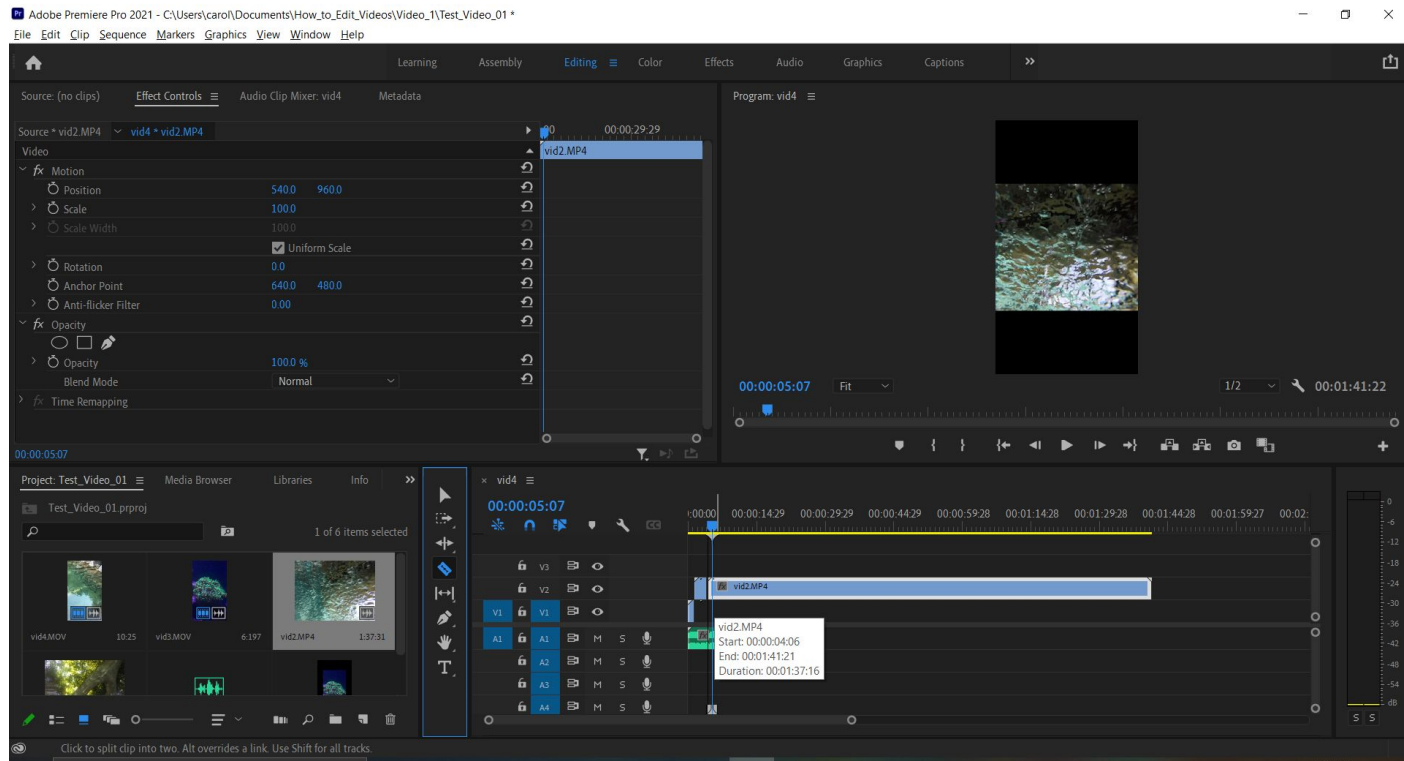


Tip - Another Way to Cut Video

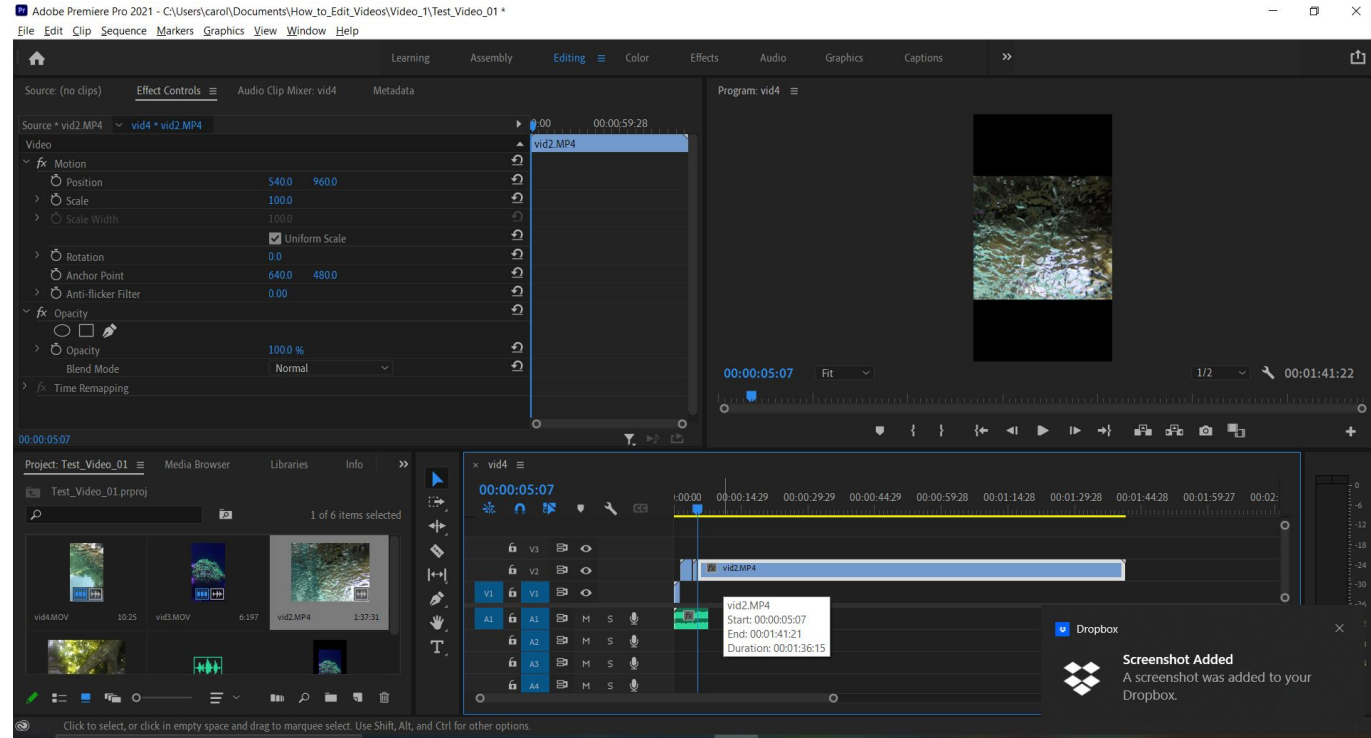
As a tip you can use the red slider that shows up if you click and drag from the end of a video clip



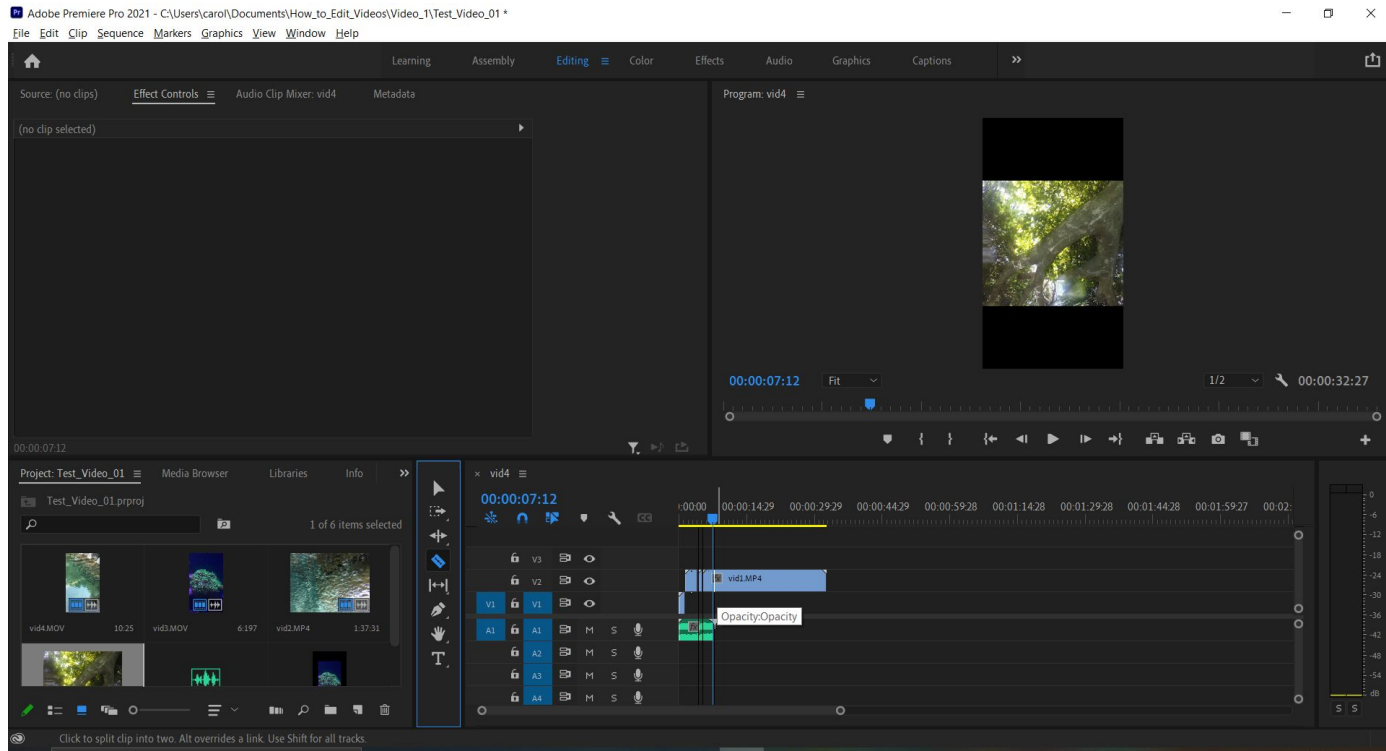
Cutting the videos to line up with the audio

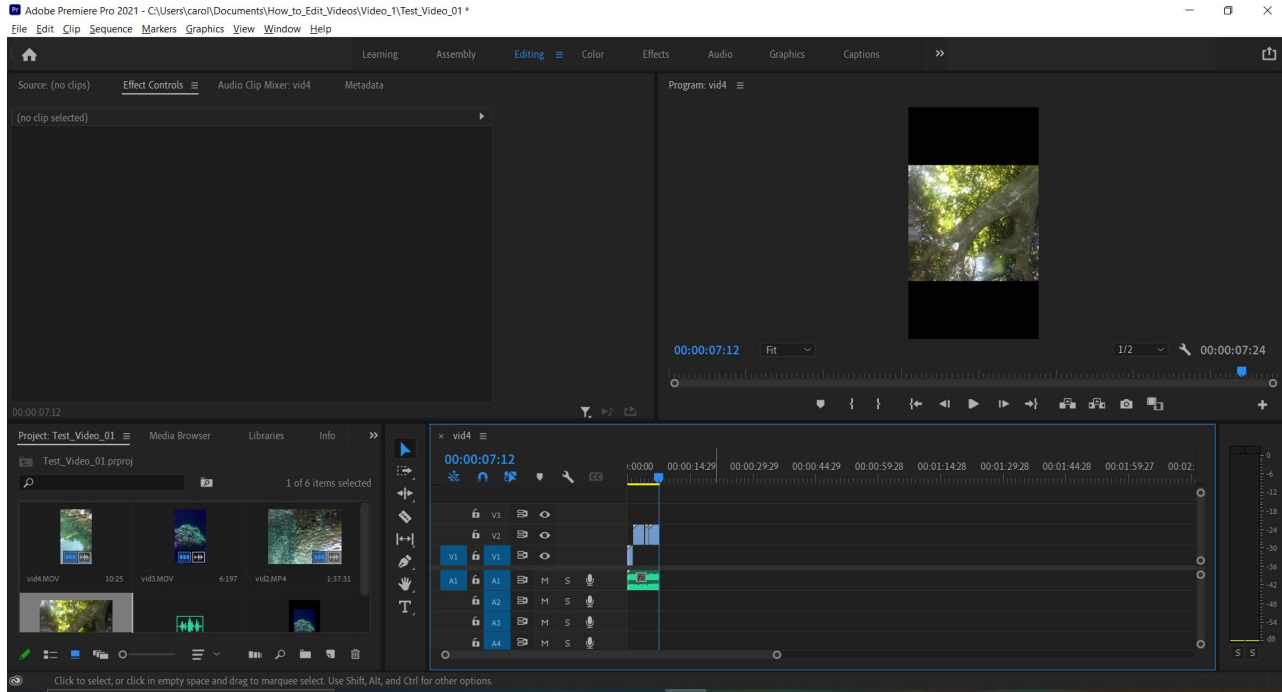

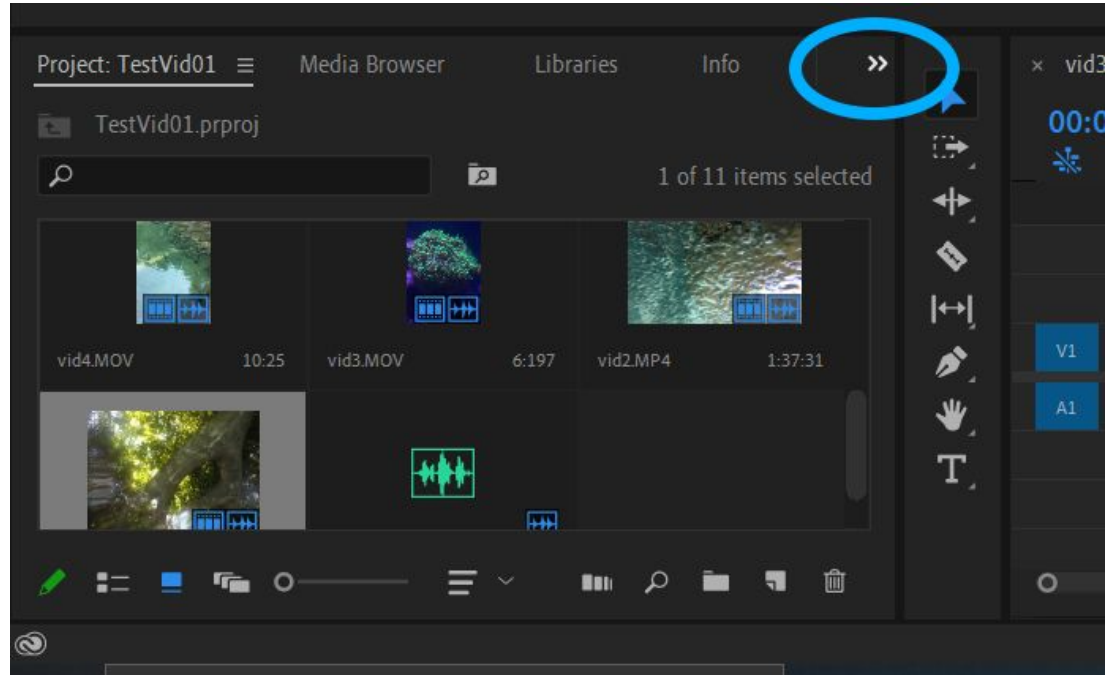
Videos match up to Audio

Now that the videos match up with the audio it is time to add effects and transitions



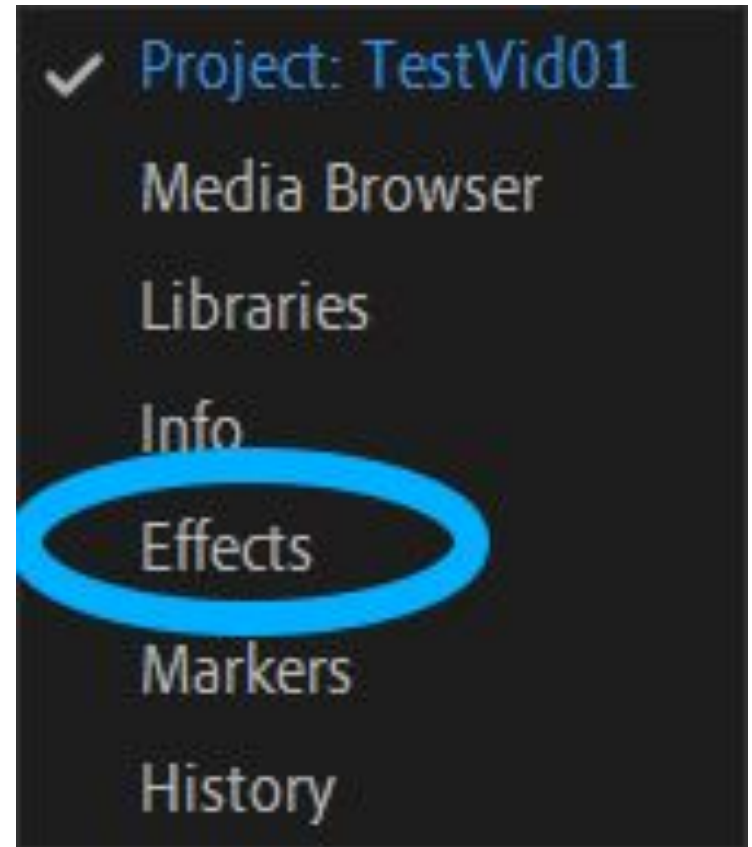
How to Add Effects

To add effects to a video go to your Project window select the double arrows



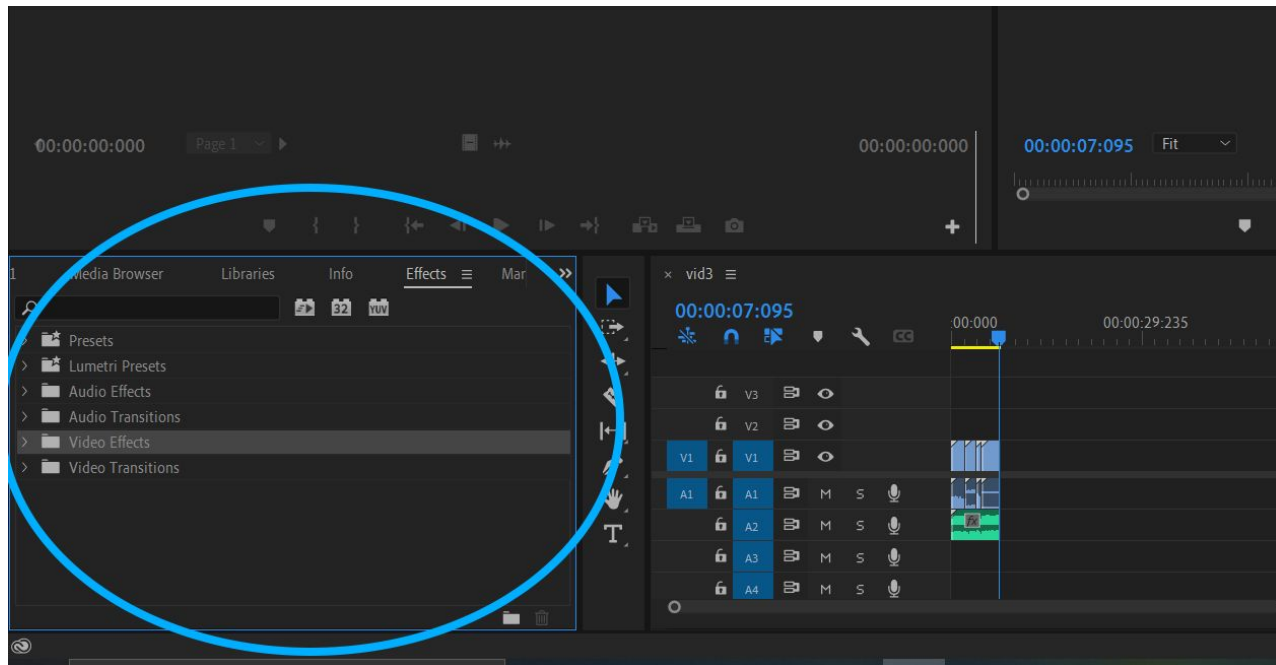
How to Add Effects

Select on the Effects tab



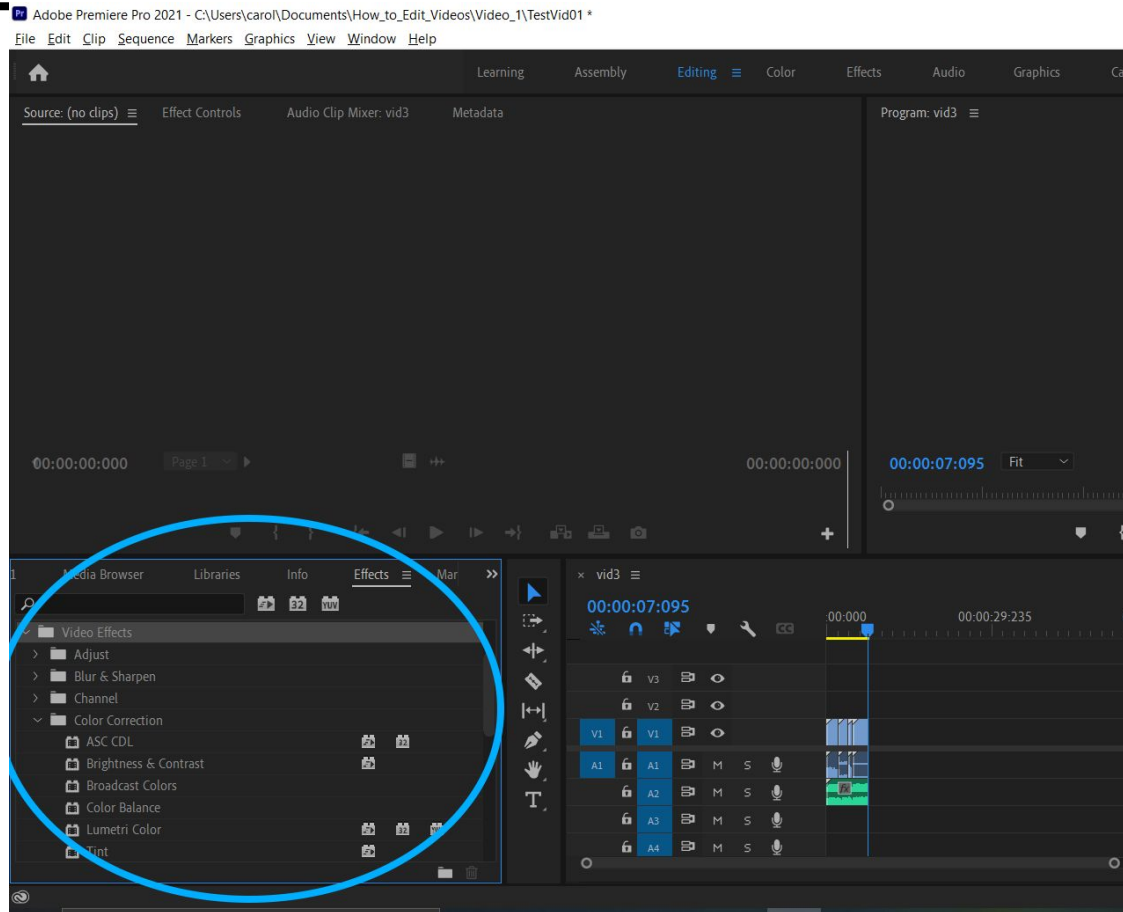

Effect



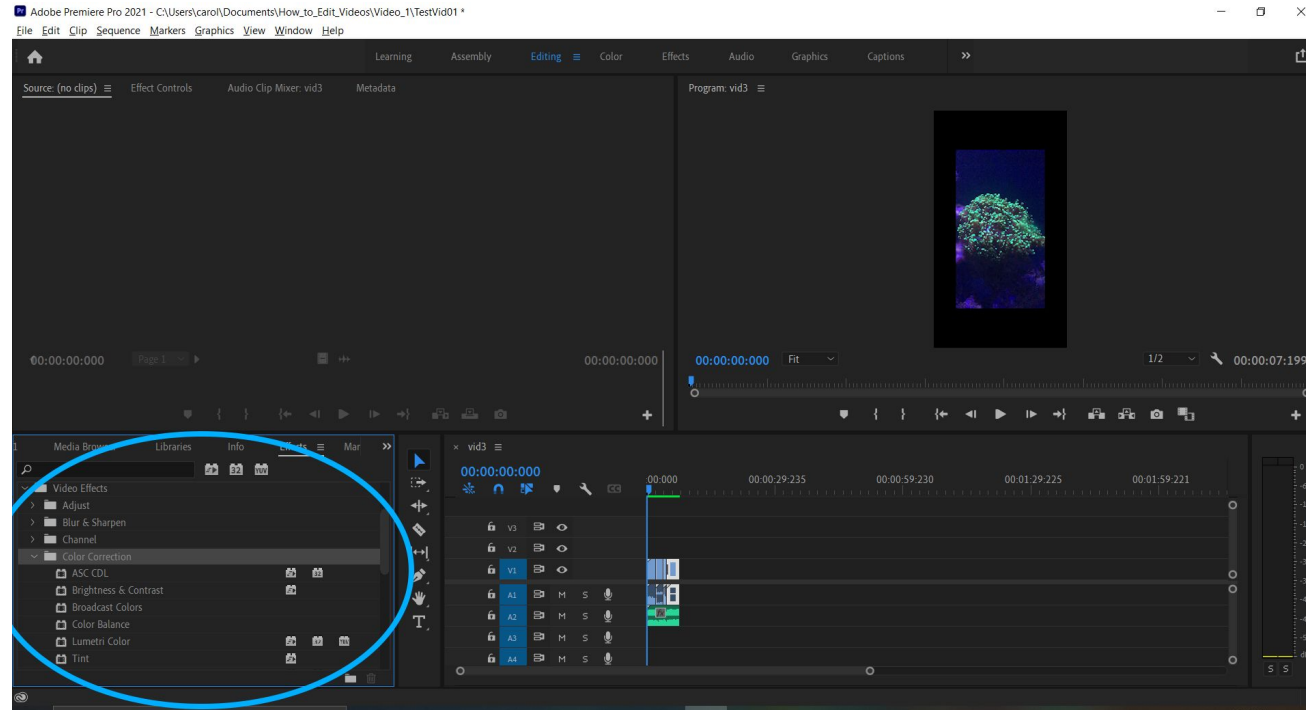

Then select the Video Effects tab



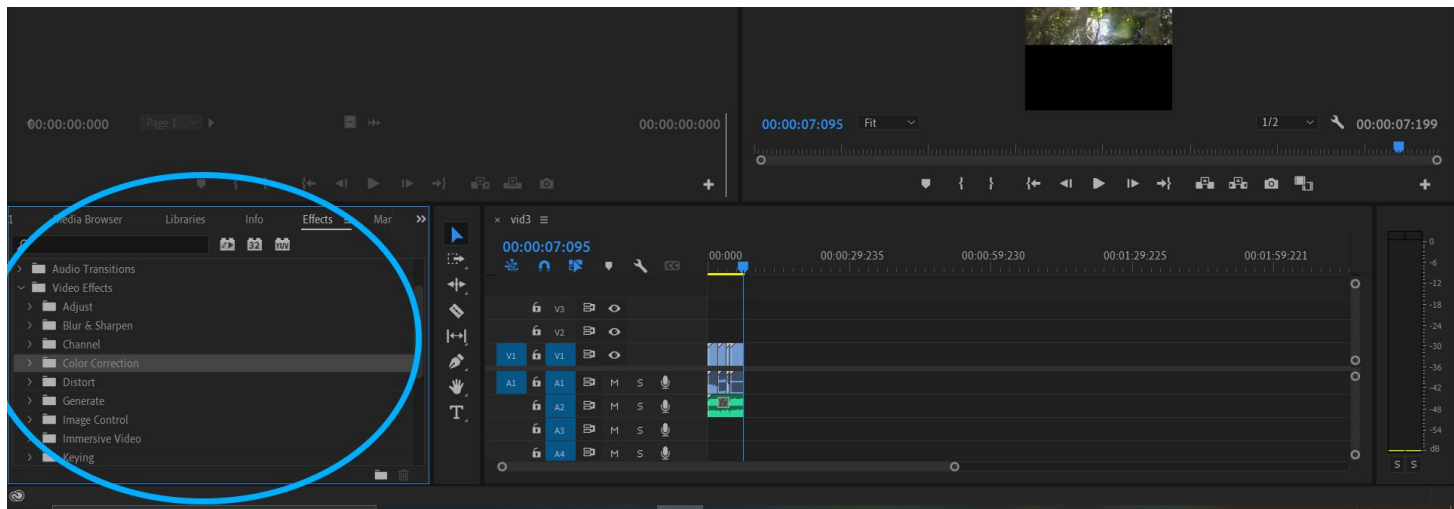

Scroll down to Video Effect



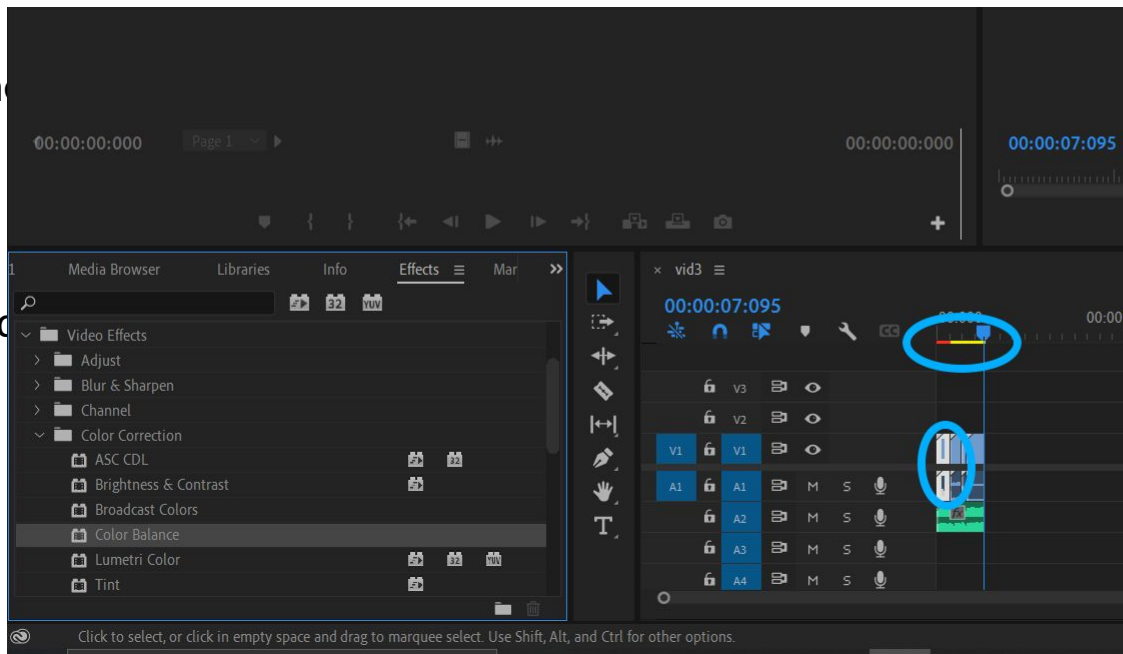
Color Balance

Select Color
Correction >
Color Balance

timeline



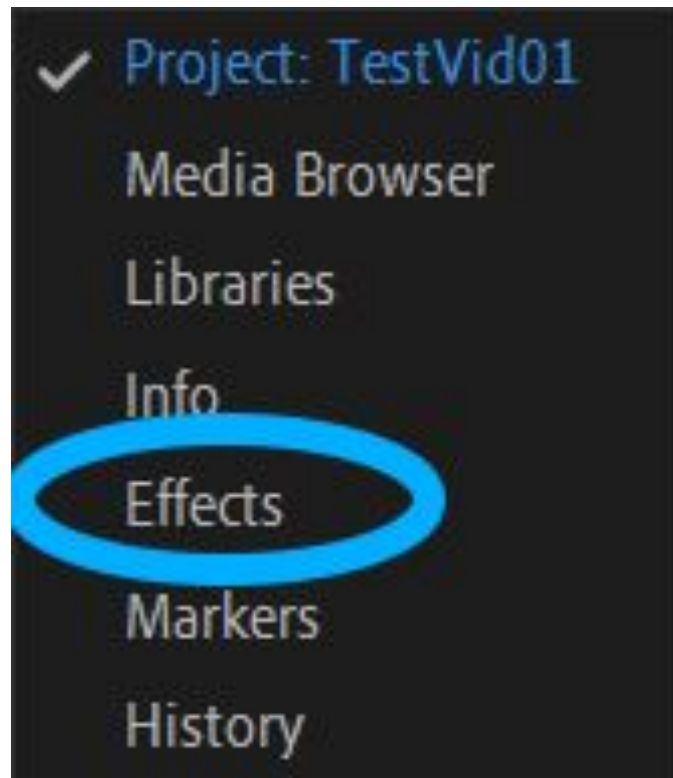
Dragging Color Balance on to the Video

As you drag Color Balance on to the timeline you will notice the yellow bar above the videos will start to become red to do not be alarmed this is normal and will be addressed later in the slides



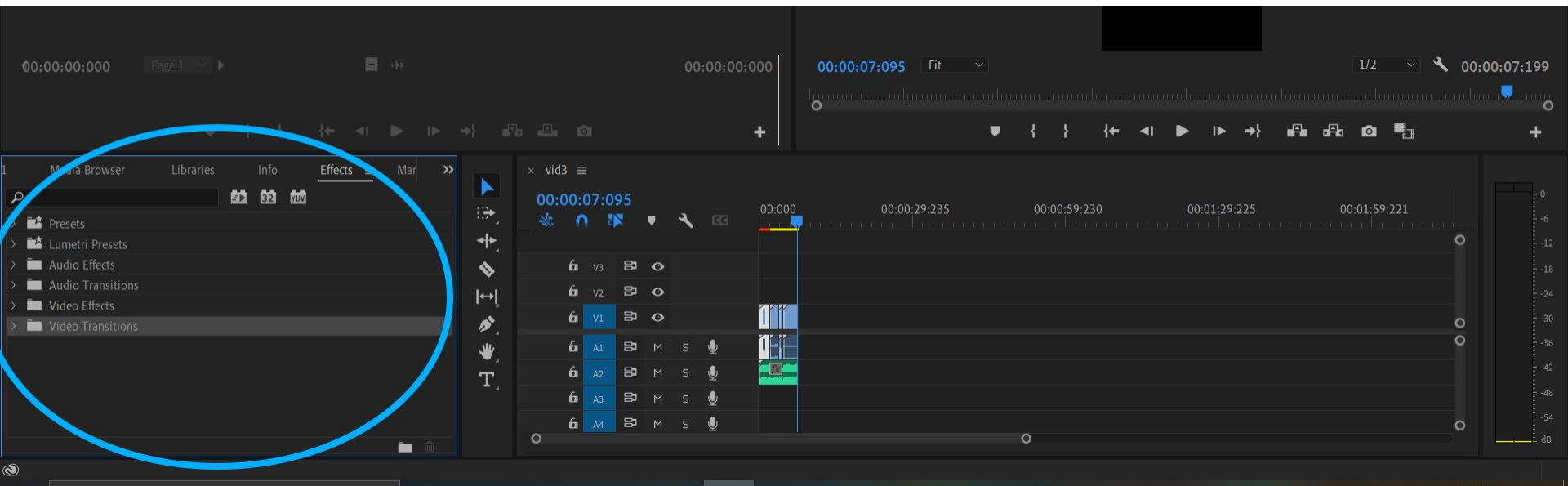
How to add Transitions

To add transitions to videos you will need to have either two videos or have cut one video. Again go to your Project window and select on the Effects tab



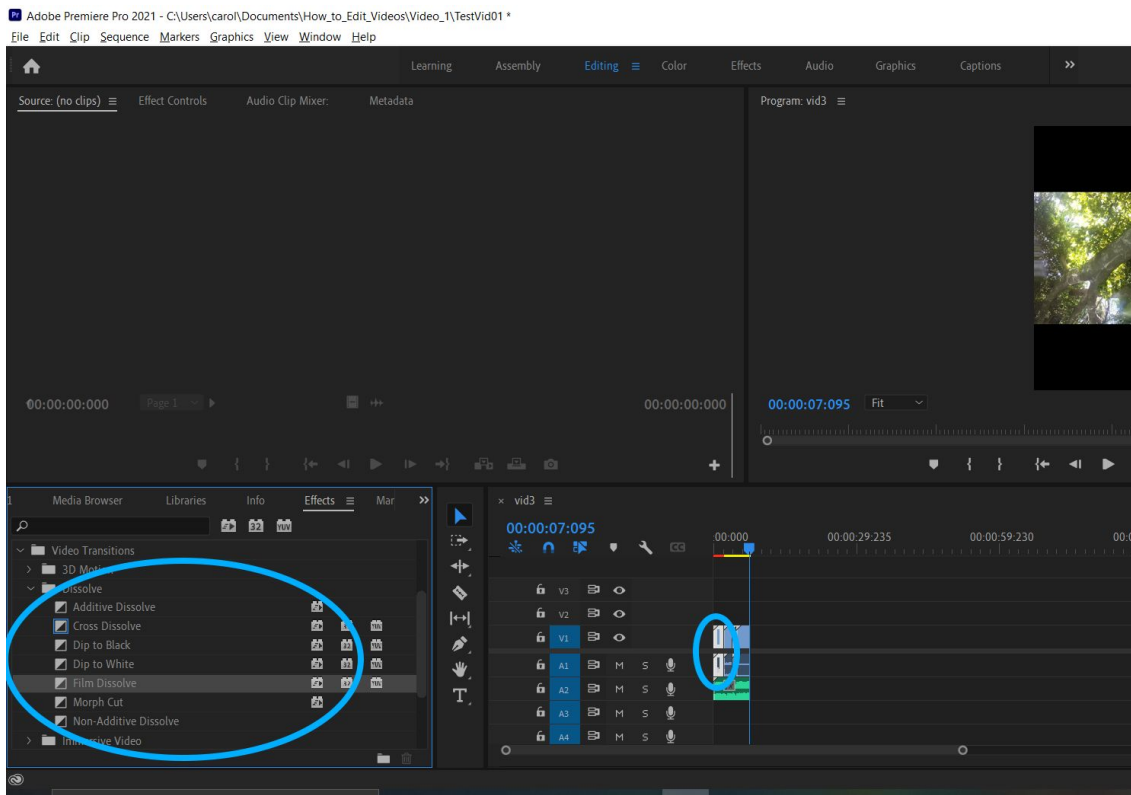
Video Transitions

Go to Video Transitions



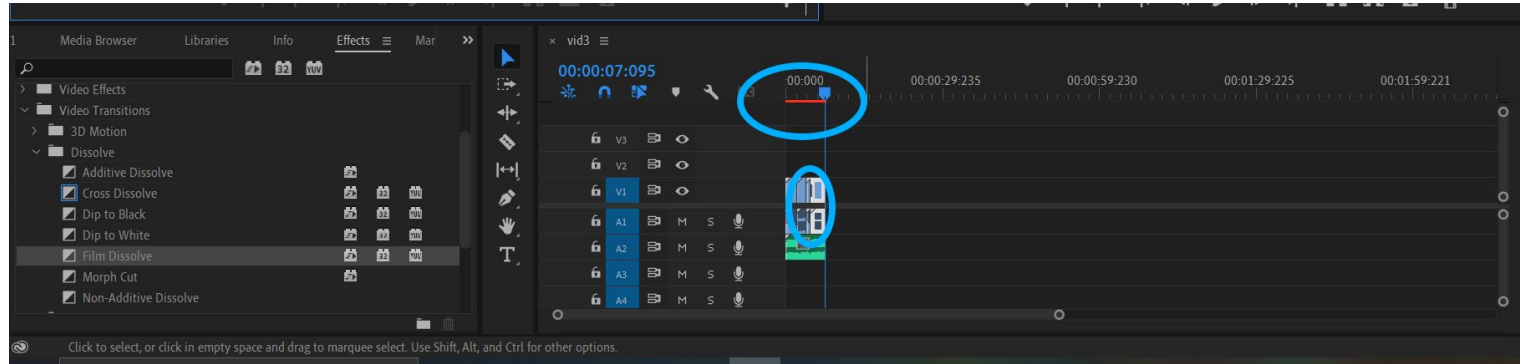
Video Transitions

Select Video Transitions > then select which transition works best or is in trend (currently Film Dissolve is trending) then drag it between the video clips on the timeline



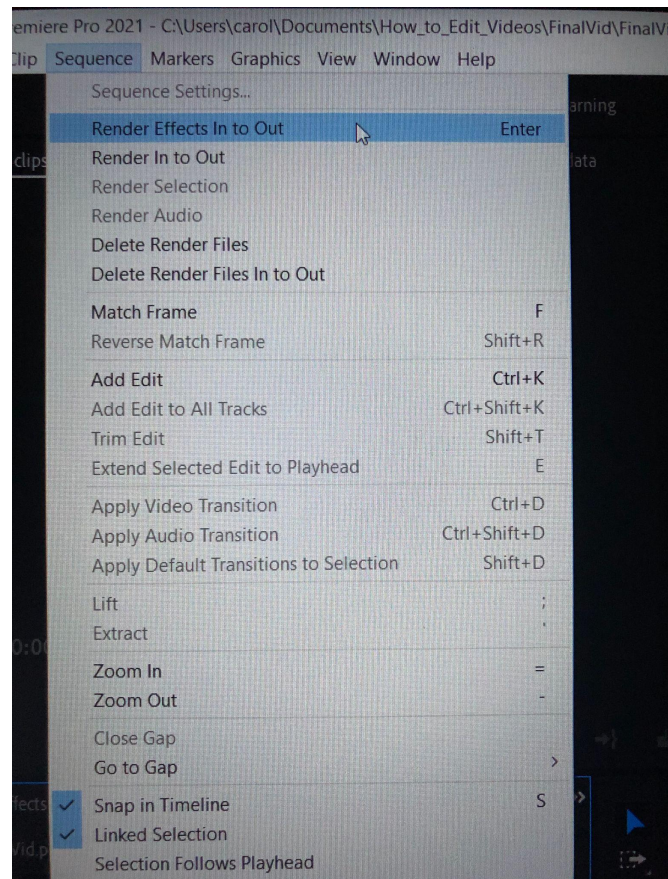
Transition between two Videos

Showing the transition as a yellow square between the two videos as well as the red bar above the videos



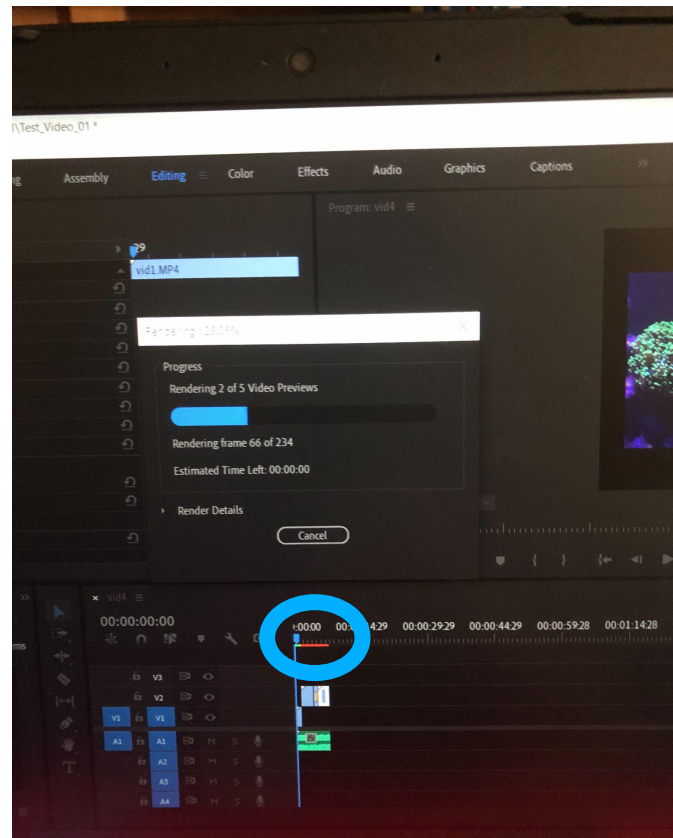
Addressing Red Line

After cutting, adding effects, and transitions go to Sequence > Render Effects In to Out



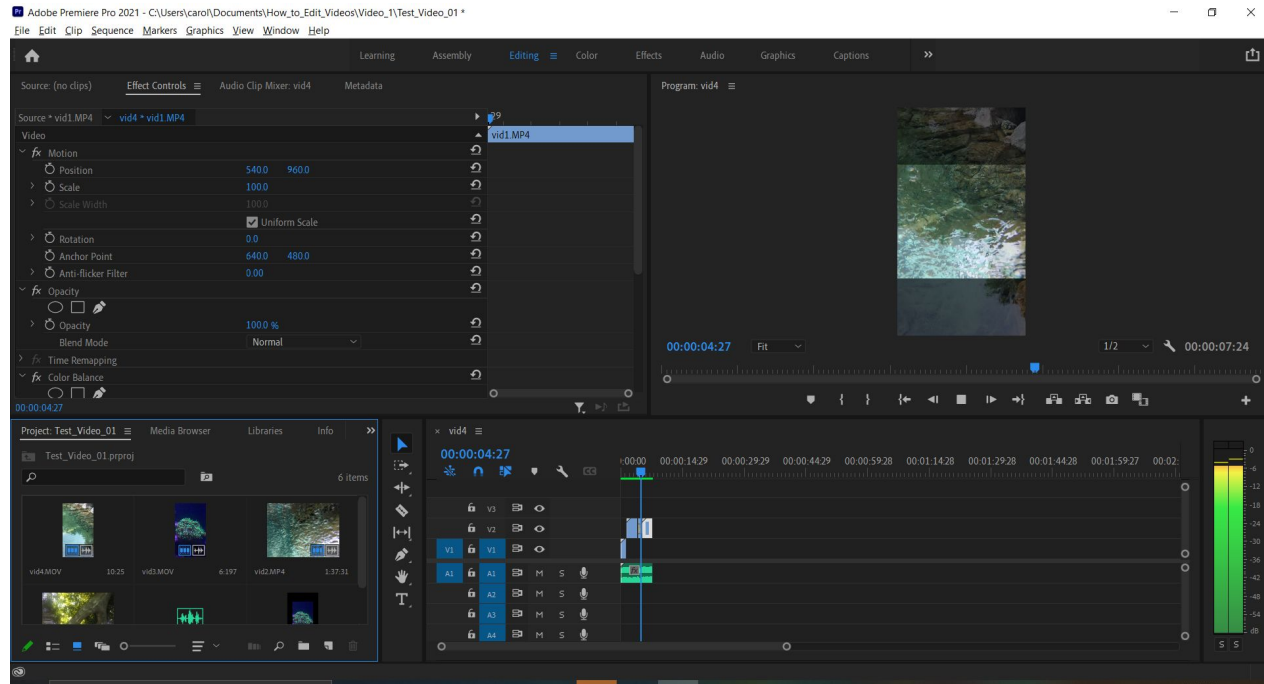
Rendering Effects

It will show up as a box saying that it is rendering the effects and you will see a bar above your videos going from red to green.



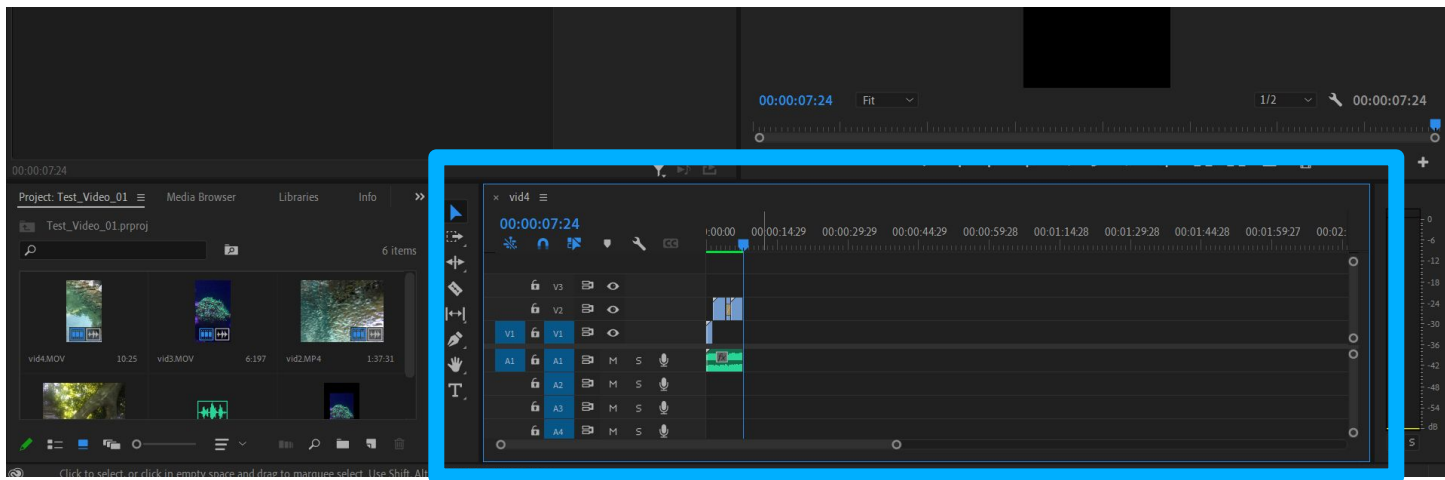
Let Video Play Out

the render sequence



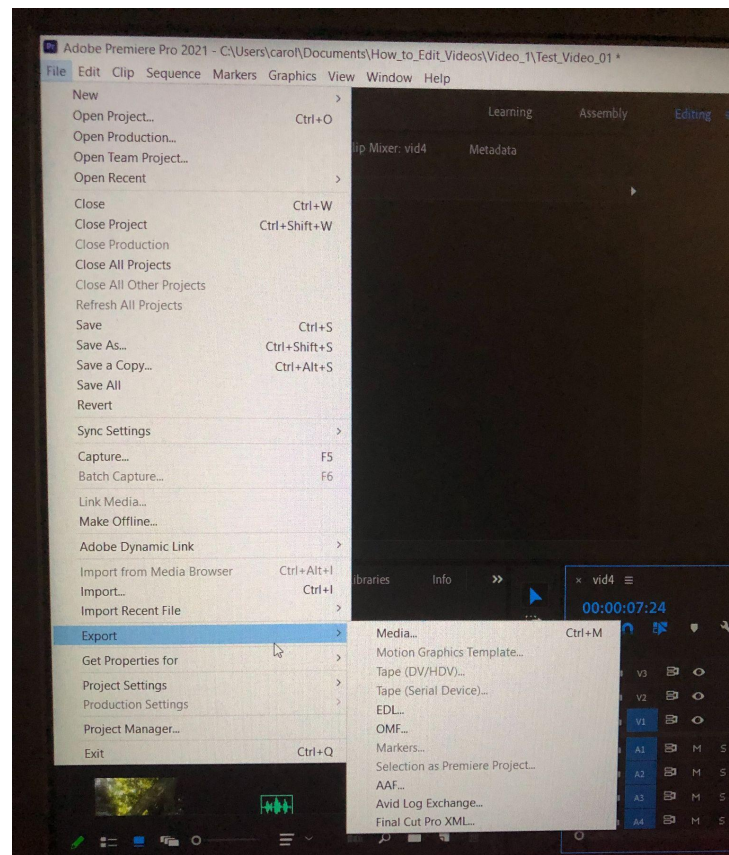
Before Exporting

Before exporting your video make sure you are selected on the timeline (it should be highlighted with a blue box around it)



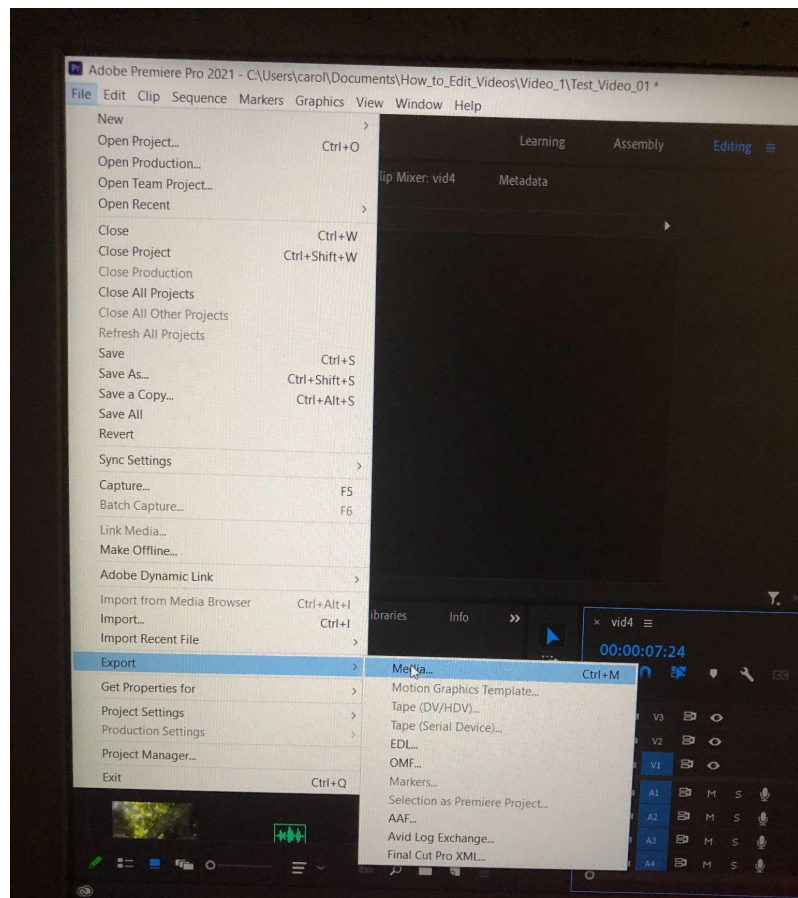
Exporting

Then go to File > Export

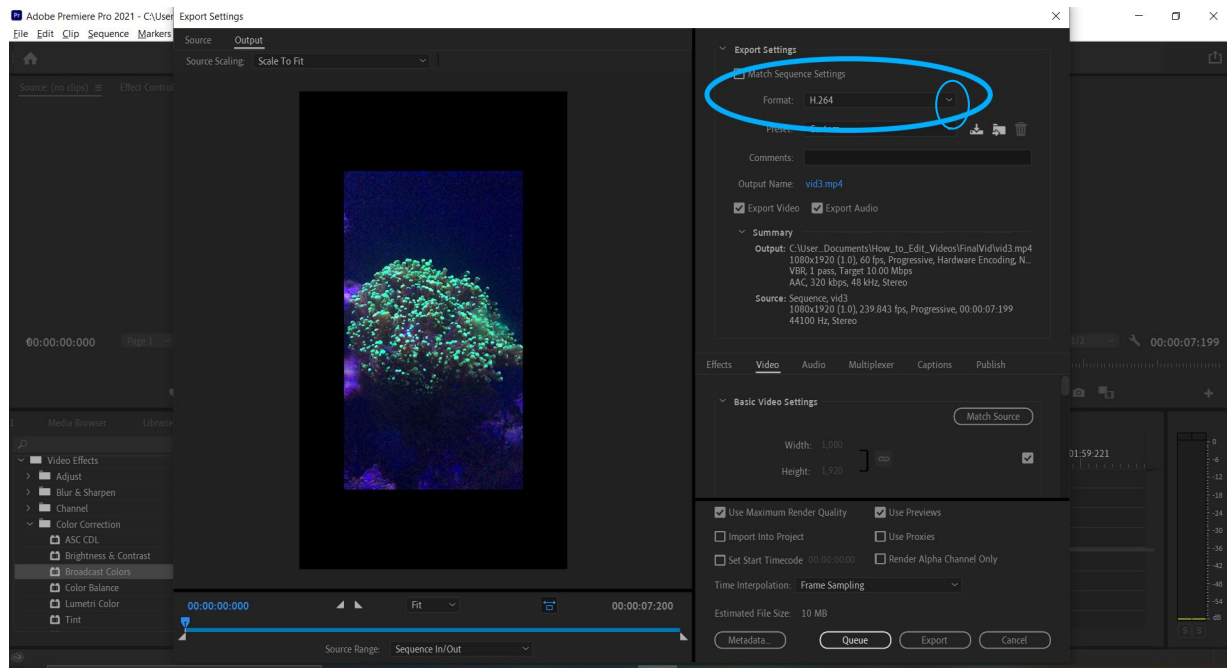
Select Media



Export Settings

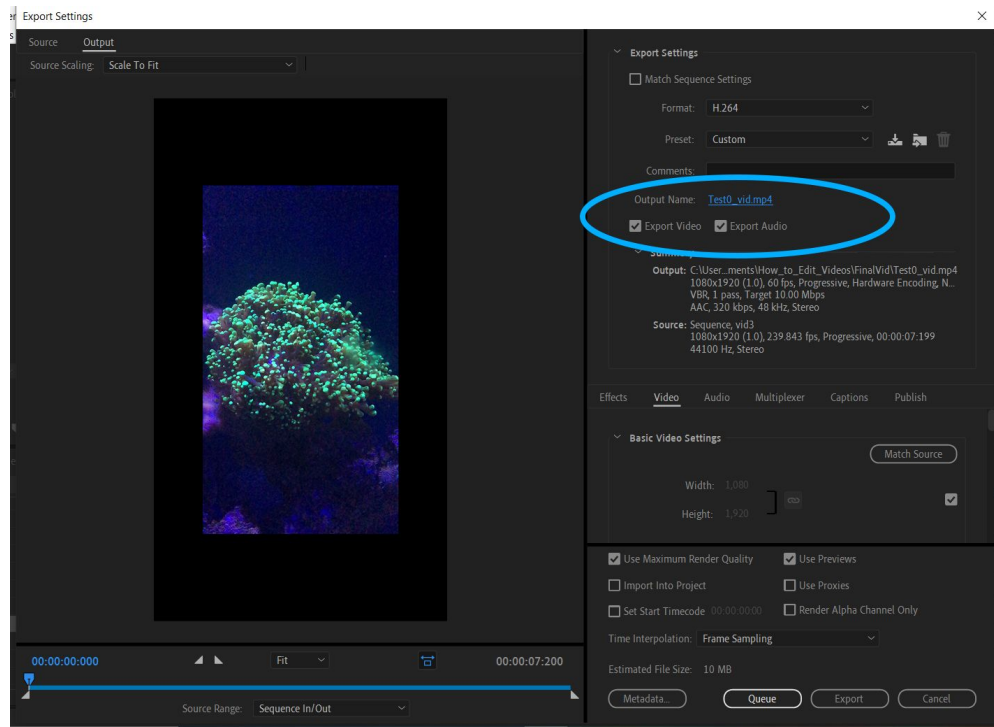
The Export Settings box should be popped up and make sure your format is H.264 - you can select this by using the drop down arrow.

*Note: H.264 is used because it is the industry standard in the film industry and is widely used for video formats.



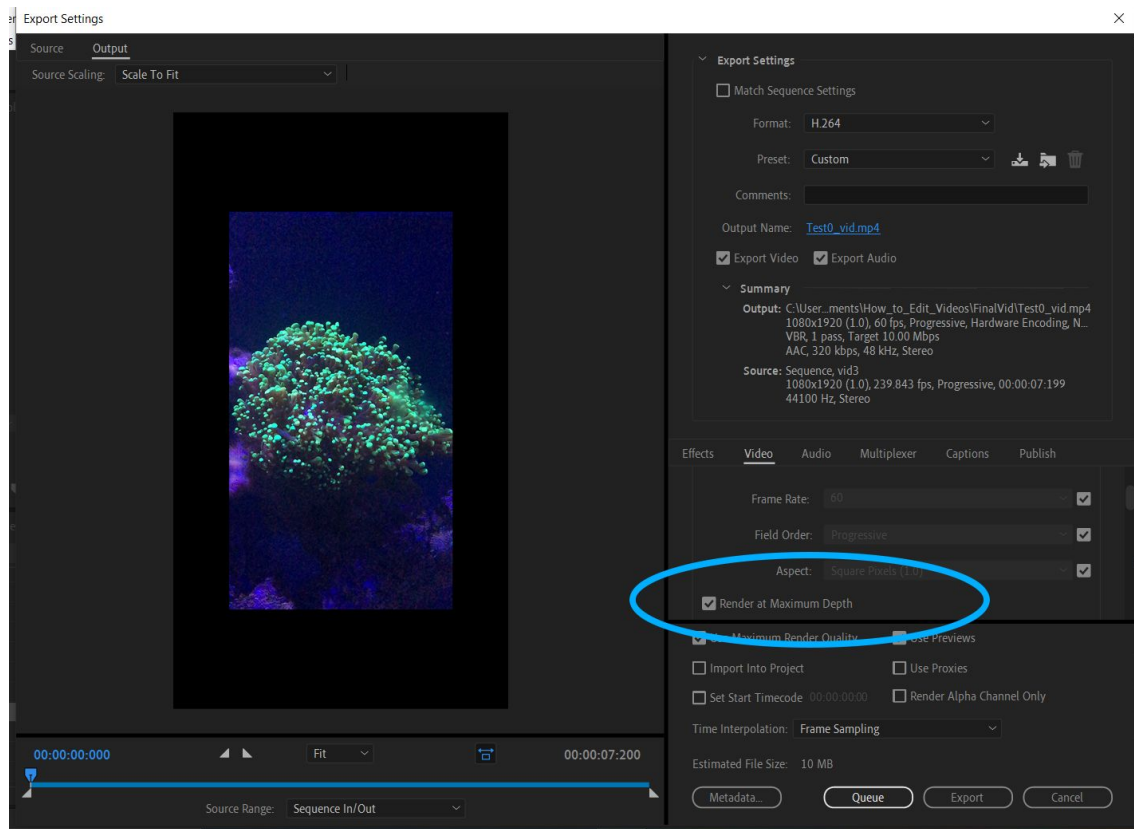
Saving it to Video_1 Folder

Change the output name to whatever you wish to name it and make sure it is still saving to the desired file and then make sure it is exporting the video and audio (these will have a box and a checkmark next to them)



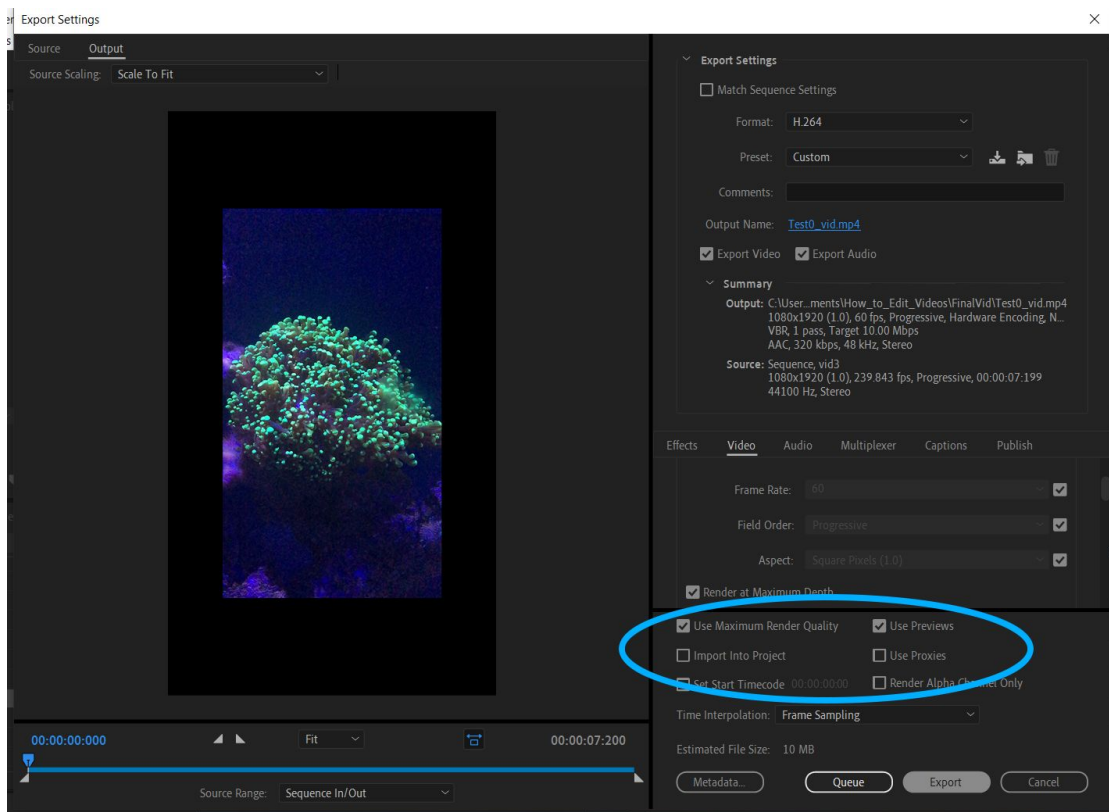
Exporting Settings

Scroll down and make sure your frame rate (usually 24 or 30), field order (progressive) are correct and then select the box saying Render at Maximum Depth



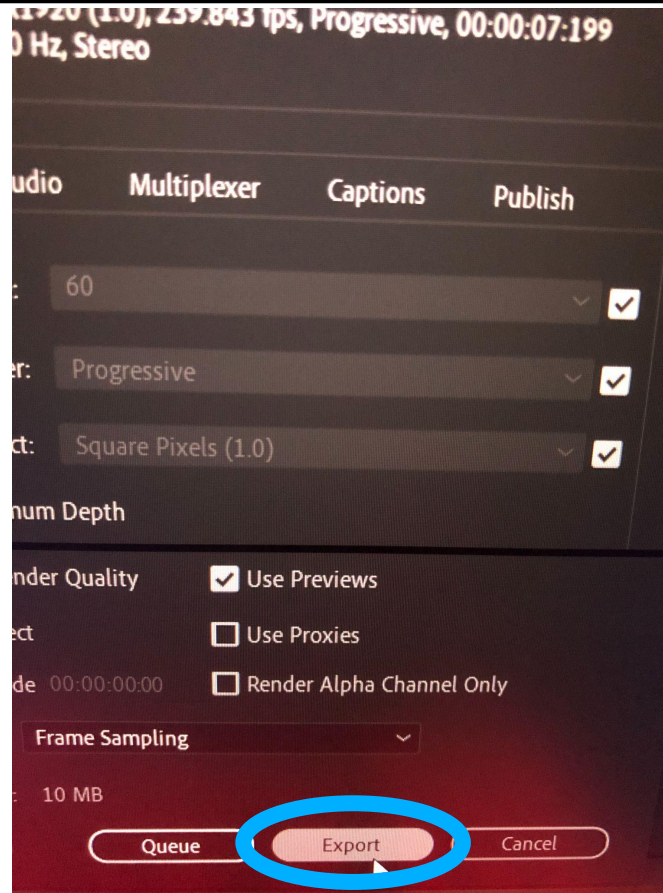
Export Settings

Then you should see 6 boxes unchecked, select the two boxes saying Use Maximum Render Quality, and Use Previews and make sure Time Interpolation is selected on Frame Sampling then press export



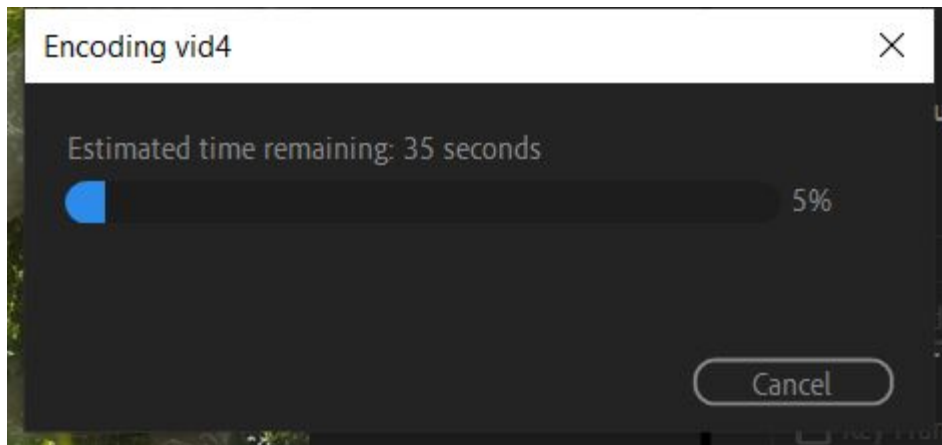
Exporting

Then select export



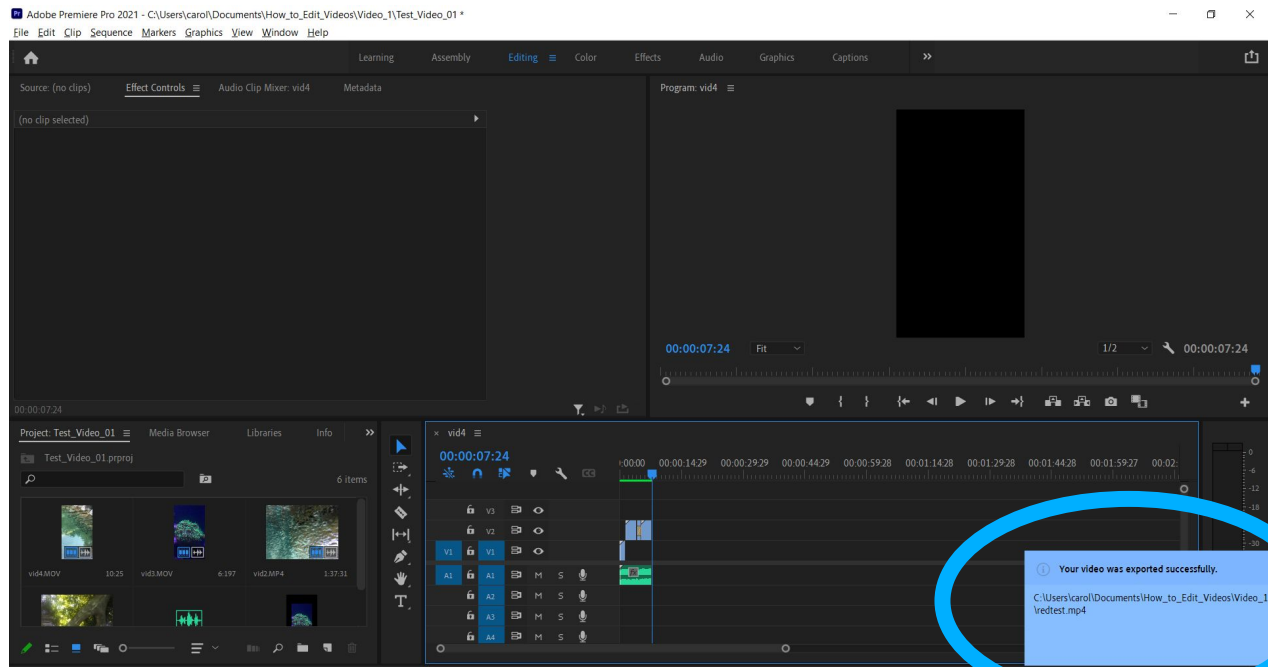
Exporting

A box will pop up saying export and encoding and wait for your video to finish exporting



Blue Box

A blue box will also appear showing that your video has exported and where you saved it to
